20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:		
21	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 6-101, as		
22	last amended by Section 5, Chapter 47, 1st Extraordinary Session,		
23	O.S.L. 2023 (47 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 6-101), is amended to read		
24	as follows:		

1 Section 6-101. A. No person, except those hereinafter 2 expressly exempted in Sections 6-102 and 6-102.1 of this title, shall operate any motor vehicle upon a highway in this state unless 3 4 the person has a valid Oklahoma driver license for the class of 5 vehicle being operated under the provisions of this title. No person shall be permitted to possess more than one valid license at 6 7 any time, except as provided in paragraph 4 of subsection F of this 8 section.

9 в. 1. No person shall operate a Class A commercial motor 10 vehicle unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and 11 holds a valid Class A commercial license, except as provided in 12 paragraph 5 of this subsection and subsection F of this section. 13 Any person holding a valid Class A commercial license shall be 14 permitted to operate motor vehicles in Classes A, B, C and D, except 15 as provided for in paragraph 4 of this subsection.

16 2. No person shall operate a Class B commercial motor vehicle 17 unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and holds a 18 valid Class B commercial license, except as provided in paragraph 5 19 of subsection F of this section. Any person holding a valid Class B 20 commercial license shall be permitted to operate motor vehicles in 21 Classes B, C and D, except as provided for in paragraph 4 of this 22 subsection.

3. No person shall operate a Class C commercial motor vehicle
unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and holds a

1 valid Class C commercial license, except as provided in subsection F 2 Any person holding a valid Class C commercial of this section. license shall be permitted to operate motor vehicles in Classes C 3 4 and D, except as provided for in paragraph 4 of this subsection. 5 4. No person under twenty-one (21) years of age shall be licensed to operate any motor vehicle which is required to be 6 7 placarded for hazardous materials pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Part 172, subpart F, except as provided in subsection F of this section; 8 9 provided, a person eighteen (18) years of age or older may be 10 licensed to operate a farm vehicle which is required to be placarded 11 for hazardous materials pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Part 172, subpart F, 12 except as provided in subsection F of this section. 13 5. A person at least seventeen (17) years of age who 14 successfully completes all examinations required by law may be 15 issued by Service Oklahoma: 16 a restricted Class A commercial license which shall а. 17 grant to the licensee the privilege to operate a Class 18 A or Class B commercial motor vehicle for harvest 19 purposes or a Class D motor vehicle, or a restricted Class B commercial license which shall 20 b. 21 grant to the licensee the privilege to operate a Class 22 B commercial motor vehicle for harvest purposes or a 23 Class D motor vehicle.

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6. No person shall operate a Class D motor vehicle unless the
 person is sixteen (16) years of age or older and holds a valid Class
 D license, except as provided for in Section 6-102 or 6-105 of this
 title. Any person holding a valid Class D license shall be
 permitted to operate motor vehicles in Class D only.

C. Any person issued a driver license pursuant to this section
may exercise the privilege thereby granted upon all streets and
highways in this state.

9 D. No person shall operate a motorcycle or motor-driven cycle without having a valid Class A, B, C or D license with a motorcycle 10 11 endorsement. Except as otherwise provided by law, any new applicant 12 for an original driver license shall be required to successfully 13 complete a written examination, vision examination and driving 14 examination for a motorcycle as prescribed by the Department of 15 Public Safety, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma, and a certified 16 state-approved motorcycle basic rider course approved by the 17 Department, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma, if the applicant 18 is seventeen (17) years of age or younger to be eligible for a 19 motorcycle endorsement thereon. The written examination and driving 20 examination for a motorcycle shall be waived by Service Oklahoma 21 upon verification that the person has successfully completed a 22 certified Motorcycle Safety Foundation rider course approved by the 23 Department, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma.

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1 E. Except as otherwise provided by law, any person who lawfully 2 possesses a valid Oklahoma driver license which is eligible for renewal shall be required to successfully complete a written 3 4 examination, vision examination and driving examination for a 5 motorcycle as prescribed by the Department, in conjunction with 6 Service Oklahoma, and a certified state-approved motorcycle basic 7 rider course approved by the Department, in conjunction with Service 8 Oklahoma, if the person is seventeen (17) years of age or younger to 9 be eligible for a motorcycle endorsement. The written examination 10 and driving examination for a motorcycle shall be waived by Service 11 Oklahoma upon verification that the person has successfully 12 completed a certified Motorcycle Safety Foundation rider course 13 approved by the Department, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma. 14 Any person eighteen (18) years of age or older may apply F. 1. 15 for a restricted Class A, B or C commercial learner permit. Service 16 Oklahoma, after the applicant has passed all parts of the 17 examination for a Class D license and has successfully passed all 18 parts of the examination for a Class A, B or C commercial license 19 other than the driving examination, may issue to the applicant a 20 commercial learner permit which shall entitle the person having 21 immediate lawful possession of the commercial learner permit and a 22 valid Oklahoma driver license or provisional driver license pursuant 23 to Section 6-212 of this title to operate a Class A, B or C 24 commercial motor vehicle upon the public highways solely for the

purpose of behind-the-wheel training in accordance with rules
 promulgated by the Department.

This commercial learner permit shall be issued for a period 3 2. 4 as provided in Section 6-115 of this title of one hundred eighty 5 (180) days, which may be renewed one time for an additional one hundred eighty (180) days; provided, such commercial learner permit 6 7 may be suspended, revoked, canceled, denied or disqualified at the discretion of the Department, with notice to Service Oklahoma, for 8 9 violation of the restrictions, for failing to give the required or 10 correct information on the application or for violation of any 11 traffic laws of this state pertaining to the operation of a motor 12 vehicle. Except as otherwise provided, the lawful possessor of a 13 commercial learner permit who has been issued a commercial learner 14 permit for a minimum of fourteen (14) days may have the restriction 15 requiring an accompanying driver removed by satisfactorily 16 completing a driver's examination; provided, the removal of a 17 restriction shall not authorize the operation of a Class A, B or C 18 commercial motor vehicle if such operation is otherwise prohibited 19 by law.

3. No person shall apply for and Service Oklahoma shall not
issue an original Class A, B or C driver license until the person
has been issued a commercial learner permit and held the permit for
at least fourteen (14) days. Any person who currently holds a Class
B or C license and who wishes to apply for another class of

1 commercial driver license shall be required to apply for a 2 commercial learner permit and to hold the permit for at least fourteen (14) days before applying for the Class A or B license, as 3 4 applicable. Any person who currently holds a Class A, B or C 5 license and who wishes to add an endorsement or remove a restriction for which a skills examination is required shall be required to 6 7 apply for a commercial learner permit and to hold the permit for at least fourteen (14) days before applying for the endorsement. 8

9 4. A commercial learner permit shall be issued by Service 10 Oklahoma as a separate and unique document which shall be valid only 11 in conjunction with a valid Oklahoma driver license or provisional 12 driver license pursuant to Section 6-212 of this title, both of 13 which shall be in the possession of the person to whom they have 14 been issued whenever that person is operating a commercial motor 15 vehicle as provided in this subsection.

16 5. After one renewal of a commercial learner permit, as 17 provided in paragraph 2 of this subsection, a commercial permit 18 shall not be renewed again. Any person who has held a commercial 19 learner permit for the initial issuance period and one renewal 20 period shall not be eliqible for and Service Oklahoma shall not 21 issue another renewal of the permit; provided, the person may 22 reapply for a new commercial learner permit, as provided for in this 23 subsection.

G. 1. For purposes of this title:

1 "REAL ID Compliant Driver License" or "Identification a. 2 Card" means a driver license or identification card issued by this state that has been certified by the 3 4 United States Department of Homeland Security (USDHS) 5 as compliant with the requirements of the REAL ID Act 6 of 2005, Public Law No. 109-13. A REAL ID Compliant 7 Driver License or Identification Card and the process through which it is issued incorporate a variety of 8 9 security measures designed to protect the integrity 10 and trustworthiness of the license or card. A REAL ID 11 Compliant Driver License or Identification Card will 12 be clearly marked on the face indicating that it is a 13 compliant document, and

14 b. "REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License" or 15 "Identification Card" means a driver license or 16 identification card issued by this state that has not 17 been certified by the United States Department of 18 Homeland Security (USDHS) as being compliant with the 19 requirements of the REAL ID Act of 2005. A REAL ID 20 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card 21 will be clearly marked on the face indicating that it 22 is not compliant with the federal REAL ID Act of 2005 23 and is not acceptable for official federal purposes. 24 The driver license or identification card will have a

1 unique design or color indicator that clearly 2 distinguishes it from a compliant license or card. Original Driver License and Identification Card Issuance: 3 2. 4 Application for an original REAL ID Compliant or REAL a. 5 ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card shall be made to Service Oklahoma. 6 7 b. Service Oklahoma employees shall perform all document recognition and other requirements needed for approval 8 9 of an original REAL ID Compliant or REAL ID 10 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card 11 application. Upon approval of an original REAL ID Compliant or REAL 12 с. 13 ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card 14 application, the applicant may take the approved 15 application document to a licensed operator to receive 16 a temporary driver license or identification card. 17 d. The licensed operator shall process the approved REAL 18 ID Compliant or REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or 19 Identification Card application and upon payment shall 20 provide the applicant a temporary driver license or 21 identification card. A temporary driver license or 22 identification card shall afford the holder the 23 privileges otherwise granted by the specific class of 24 driver license or identification card for the period

of time listed on the temporary driver license or identification card or the period of time prior to the applicant receiving a REAL ID Compliant or REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card, whichever time period is shorter.

6 3. REAL ID Compliant Driver License and Identification Card7 Renewal and Replacement:

Application for renewal or replacement of a REAL ID 8 a. 9 Compliant Driver License or Identification Card may be 10 made to Service Oklahoma or to a licensed operator; 11 provided, such licensed operator is authorized to 12 process application for REAL ID Compliant Driver 13 Licenses and Identification Cards. A licensed 14 operator may process the voluntary downgrade of a REAL 15 ID Compliant Commercial Driver License to any lower 16 class license upon request of the licensee; provided, 17 no additional endorsements or restrictions are placed 18 on the license.

b. Service Oklahoma employees or authorized licensed
operators shall perform all document recognition and
other requirements needed for approval of a renewal or
replacement REAL ID Compliant Driver License or
Identification Card application.

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- c. Upon approval of a renewal or replacement REAL ID
 Compliant Driver License or Identification Card
 application, the applicant may receive a temporary
 driver license or identification card from Service
 Oklahoma or an authorized licensed operator.
- A temporary driver license or identification card 6 d. 7 acquired under the provisions of this paragraph shall afford the holder the privileges otherwise granted by 8 9 the specific class of driver license or identification 10 card being renewed or replaced for the period of time 11 listed on the temporary driver license or 12 identification card or the period of time prior to the 13 applicant receiving a REAL ID Compliant Driver License 14 or Identification Card, whichever time period is 15 shorter.
- e. For purposes of this title, an application for a REAL
 ID Compliant Driver License or Identification Card by
 an individual with a valid Oklahoma-issued driver
 license or identification card shall be considered a
 renewal of a REAL ID Compliant Driver License or
 Identification Card.
- 4. REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License and Identification CardRenewal and Replacement:
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1 Application for renewal or replacement of a REAL ID a. 2 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card may be made to Service Oklahoma or to a licensed operator. 3 4 A licensed operator may process the voluntary 5 downgrade of a REAL ID Noncompliant Commercial Driver 6 License to any lower class license upon request of the licensee; provided, no additional endorsements or 7 restrictions are added to the license. 8

- 9 b. Service Oklahoma employees or licensed operators shall
 10 perform all document recognition and other
 11 requirements needed for approval of a renewal or
 12 replacement REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or
 13 Identification Card application.
- 14 c. Upon approval of a renewal or replacement REAL ID
 15 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card
 16 application, the applicant may receive a temporary
 17 driver license or identification card from Service
 18 Oklahoma or a licensed operator.
- 19d. A temporary driver license or identification card20acquired under the provisions of this paragraph shall21afford the holder the privileges otherwise granted by22the specific class of driver license or identification23card being renewed or replaced for the period of time24listed on the temporary driver license or

P. No person who has been honorably discharged from active
service in any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States or
Oklahoma National Guard and who has been certified by the United
States Department of Veterans Affairs, its successor or the Armed
Forces of the United States to be a disabled veteran in receipt of

1 compensation at the one-hundred-percent rate for a permanent 2 disability sustained through military action or accident resulting from disease contracted while in such active service and registered 3 4 with the veterans registry created by the Oklahoma Department of 5 Veterans Affairs shall be charged a fee for the issuance, replacement or renewal of an Oklahoma driver license; provided, that 6 7 if a veteran has been previously exempt from a fee pursuant to this subsection, no registration with the veterans registry shall be 8 9 required.

10 In accordance with the provisions of subsection G of this Ο. 11 section, Service Oklahoma is authorized to promulgate rules for the 12 issuance and renewal of driver licenses authorized pursuant to the 13 provisions of Sections 6-101 through 6-309 of this title; provided, 14 that no such rules applicable to the issuance or renewal of REAL ID 15 Noncompliant Driver Licenses shall create more stringent standards 16 than such rules applicable as of January 1, 2017, unless directly 17 related to a specific change in statutory law concerning standards 18 for REAL ID Noncompliant Driver Licenses. Applications, upon forms 19 approved by Service Oklahoma, for such licenses shall be handled, in 20 accordance with the provisions of subsection G of this section, by 21 the licensed operator; provided, Service Oklahoma is authorized to 22 assume these duties in any county of this state. Each licensed 23 operator accepting applications for driver licenses shall receive 24 Six Dollars (\$6.00) for a 4-year REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License

1 or Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) for an 8-year REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for a 4-year REAL ID Compliant 2 Driver License or Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for an 8-year REAL ID 3 4 Compliant Driver License to be deducted from the total collected for 5 each license or renewal application accepted through June 30, 2023. Beginning July 1, 2022, and ending on June 30, 2023, each motor 6 7 license agent or licensed operator accepting applications for driver licenses for individuals over the age of sixty-five (65) years or 8 9 for applications for drivers pursuant to subsection P of this 10 section shall receive Six Dollars (\$6.00) for a 4-year driver 11 license or Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) for an 8-year driver license to 12 be deducted daily by the motor license agent or licensed operator 13 receipts. Beginning July 1, 2023, these fees shall be retained by 14 the licensed operator pursuant to subsection E of Section 1141.1 of 15 this title. The fees received by the licensed operator, authorized 16 by this subsection, shall be used for operating expenses. The 17 amount retained pursuant to this subsection shall not be retained by 18 any state agency. The fees received by the licensed operator, 19 authorized by this subsection, shall be used for operating expenses. 20 For purposes of this subsection, "licensed operator" shall mean an 21 individual who obtains a license from the Service Oklahoma Operator 22 Board to operate a designated Service Oklahoma location and offers 23 third-party fulfillment of designated services to be rendered by 24 Service Oklahoma.

R. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1104 of this title
and subsection Q of this section and except as provided in
subsections H and M of this section, the first Sixty Thousand
Dollars (\$60,000.00) of all monies collected pursuant to this
section shall be paid by the Oklahoma Tax Commission to the State
Treasurer to be deposited in the General Revenue Fund of the State
Treasury.

The next Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) of monies 8 9 collected pursuant to this section shall be paid by the Tax 10 Commission to the State Treasurer to be deposited each fiscal year under the provisions of this section to the credit of the Department 11 12 of Public Safety Restricted Revolving Fund for the purpose of the 13 Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunications System. All other 14 monies collected in excess of Five Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars 15 (\$560,000.00) each fiscal year shall be apportioned as provided in 16 Section 1104 of this title, except as otherwise provided in this 17 section.

18 S. Service Oklahoma shall retain the images displayed on 19 licenses and identification cards issued pursuant to the provisions 20 of Sections 6-101 through 6-309 of this title which may be used 21 only:

1. By a law enforcement agency for purposes of criminal
investigations, missing person investigations or any law enforcement

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purpose which is deemed necessary by the Commissioner of Public
 Safety;

3 2. By the driver licensing agency of another state for its4 official purpose; and

3. As provided in Section 2-110 of this title.

All agencies approved by the Oklahoma Law Enforcement
Telecommunications System (OLETS) or the National Law Enforcement
Telecommunications System (NLETS) to receive photographs or
computerized images may obtain them through OLETS or through NLETS.
Photographs or computerized images may be obtained by law
enforcement one inquiry at a time.

12 The computer system and related equipment acquired for this 13 purpose must conform to industry standards for interoperability and 14 open architecture. The Department of Public Safety may promulgate 15 rules to implement the provisions of this subsection.

16 T. No person may hold more than one state-issued or territory-17 issued REAL ID Compliant Driver License or REAL ID Compliant 18 Identification Card from Oklahoma or any other state or territory. 19 Service Oklahoma shall not issue a REAL ID Compliant Driver License 20 to a person who has been previously issued a REAL ID Compliant 21 Driver License or REAL ID Compliant Identification Card until such 22 license or identification card has been surrendered to Service 23 Oklahoma by the applicant. Service Oklahoma may promulgate rules

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related to the issuance of replacement REAL ID Compliant Driver
 Licenses in the event of loss or theft.

Beginning May 24, 2021, and ending on June 30, 2023, in 3 U. 4 addition to the amounts provided in subsection Q of this section, a 5 licensed operator shall receive Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each 6 processed application for a REAL ID Compliant 4-year Driver License 7 and Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each processed application for a REAL 8 ID Compliant 8-year Driver License. Any additional amounts provided 9 pursuant to this subsection shall not be retained by Service 10 Oklahoma.

11 V. 1. No later than November 1, 2025, all credentials, 12 including REAL ID Compliant and REAL ID Noncompliant driver licenses 13 and identification cards, processed in this state by Service 14 Oklahoma or a licensed operator shall be printed primarily within 15 the boundaries of this state. In the event of an emergency or if 16 not economically feasible and practicable, Service Oklahoma may 17 elect, with notice to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the 18 Oklahoma State Senate, and the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of 19 Representatives, to print the credentials outside the boundaries of 20 this state. Service Oklahoma may promulgate rules to implement the 21 provisions of this subsection. 22 2. An applicant for a credential to be issued by Service 23 Oklahoma, including REAL ID Compliant and REAL ID Noncompliant 24 driver licenses and identification cards may request expedited

2 delivery, there shall be assessed, in addition to any other fees 3 provided for by law, an expedited delivery fee of Forty Dollars 4 (\$40.00), plus the cost of postage. The expedited delivery shall be 5 deposited to the Service Oklahoma Revolving Fund. 6 3. If necessary to provide adequate secure facilities for the 7 processing and printing of credentials as set forth in this 8 subsection, Service Oklahoma is authorized to purchase real estate 9 including, but not limited to, buildings or units, for no more than 10 appraised value or, in the alternative, the Executive Director of 11 Service Oklahoma is authorized to enter into a lease-purchase 12 agreement for the acquisition of such buildings or units from the 13 person or entity that will develop or build the buildings or units. 14 For the purposes of the purchase or build-out of the new facility, 15 Service Oklahoma is hereby exempted from the requirements of the 16 Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974 as provided in Sections 101 17 through 139 of Title 61 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Service Oklahoma 18 shall be required to collect multiple bids from qualified 19 contractors for the build-out of new facilities. 20 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 21 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 22 23
