8                                   COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9                   An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending  
10                   21 O.S. 2011, Section 302, which relates to criminal  
11                   penalties for disturbing legislative proceedings;  
12                   modifying scope of certain prohibited act; specifying  
13                   penalty for certain unlawful acts; and providing an  
14                   effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16                   SECTION 1.           AMENDATORY           21 O.S. 2011, Section 302, is  
17 amended to read as follows:

18                   Section 302. Any person who alone or in concert with others  
19 wilfully disturbs, disrupts or interferes with any session, meeting  
20 or proceeding of either house of the State Legislature or any  
21 committee of either house of the State Legislature, whether within  
22 or outside the presence of either house of the State Legislature or  
23 any committee, by:

- 24                   1. Engaging in violent, tumultuous or threatening behavior;

1           2. Using abusive or obscene language or making an obscene  
2 gesture;

3           3. Making unreasonable noise or displaying offensive signage;  
4 or

5           4. Congregating with other persons and refusing to comply with  
6 a lawful order of the police or security officer to disperse~~+~~,  
7 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a  
8 fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by  
9 imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding six (6) months, or by  
10 both such fine and imprisonment.

11           SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
