11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 956 of Title 63, unless there is
14 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The Chief Medical Examiner may equip vehicles that are used to
16 investigate deaths with flashing lights and sirens. The Chief
17 Medical Examiner may authorize such vehicles to exceed the maximum
18 speed limits so long as speeding does not endanger life or property.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
