7	An Act relating to higher education; requiring each
8	board of regents to adopt a housing policy prohibiting coeducational housing; defining term;

13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3249 of Title 70, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	After the effective date of this act, the board of regents for
18	each institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher
19	Education shall adopt a student housing policy that prohibits the
20	establishment and offering of coeducational housing in dormitories,
21	halls or any other type of student housing owned or operated by the
22	institution or which is located on property owned by the
23	institution. For purposes of this section, "coeducational housing"
24	shall mean housing that integrates men and women on the same floor

1 or in the same room. Each housing policy may allow for 2 coeducational rooms only for married couples or for family members 3 living together. Each housing policy may allow for coeducational 4 housing where men and women are in the same building or hall, as 5 long as men and women are not housed on the same floor or in the 6 same room and access between the housing areas for men and women are 7 controlled. 8 SECTION 2.
