7 An Act relating to state government; allowing certain
8 persons to use state purchase cards; limiting amount
9 of transaction; requiring Oklahoma Tourism and
Recreation Department to conduct audits; providing
for codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.5b of Title 74, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The State Purchasing Director may authorize purchases for the
17 Oklahoma Film & Music Office Division of the Oklahoma Tourism and
18 Recreation Department to utilize a state purchase card for
19 acquisitions for programs, functions or services essential to the
20 mission of the agency with transaction limits not to exceed Fifteen
21 Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00). The purchase cardholders are
22 required to sign a purchase card agreement prior to becoming a
23 cardholder and to attend purchase card training. The Oklahoma
24 Tourism and Recreation Department shall conduct quarterly internal

1 auditing on all purchase card transactions associated with the
2 Oklahoma Film & Music Office.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
