NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.5b of Title 74, unless there 15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 16 The State Purchasing Director may authorize purchases for the 17 Oklahoma Film & Music Office Division of the Oklahoma Tourism and 18 Recreation Department to utilize a state purchase card for 19 acquisitions for programs, functions or services essential to the 20 mission of the agency with transaction limits not to exceed Fifteen 21 Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00). The purchase cardholders are 22 required to sign a purchase card agreement prior to becoming a

cardholder and to attend purchase card training. The Oklahoma

Tourism and Recreation Department shall conduct quarterly internal
