14	SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-127 of Title 47, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. Provided an operator has obtained an annual permit from the
18	Oklahoma Department of Transportation as provided by subsection B of
19	this section, farm equipment including, but not limited to, farm
20	tractors and other implements of husbandry, as defined in Sections
21	1-118 and 1-125 of this title, that are used solely for commercial
22	non-agricultural purposes, may be operated on any road or highway of
23	this state, except those highways which are part of the National
24	System of Interstate and Defense Highways. Operation of such farm

1	equipment shall be subject to all existing height and weight
2	restrictions and equipment requirements provided by law.
3	B. The Department of Transportation shall, upon proper
4	application, issue a special annual permit to any person allowing
5	the movement of vehicles, described in subsection A of this section.
6	The fee for the annual permit shall be Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)
7	per year, per vehicle.
