11 An Act relating to transportation; designating the
12 Deputy Sheriff Michael Dee Pace Memorial Bridge;
13 designating the Landon L. Endres Memorial
14 Interchange; designating the Paul Henry Carr Memorial
15 Bridge; designating the Trooper Leon H. Brown
16 Memorial Highway; designating the 1LT Damon Leehan
17 Memorial Bridge; designating the Deputy Sean Cookson
18 Memorial Highway; designating the Senator E. Melvin
19 Porter Memorial Bridge; designating the Deputy
20 Sheriff Clifford Phillip Payne Memorial Highway;
21 amending Section 3, Chapter 307, O.S.L. 2018 (69 O.S.
22 Supp. 2018, Section 1698.271), which relates to the
23 SSG Christopher Michael Hake Memorial Bridge;
24 modifying name and location of markers; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.287 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge over Choctaw Road on U.S. Highway 69 in Bryan County
5 shall be designated as the "Deputy Sheriff Michael Dee Pace Memorial
6 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
7 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

8 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
9 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.288 of Title 69, unless
10 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

11 The interchange of Interstate 40 and Cimarron Road in Canadian
12 County shall be designated as the "Landon L. Endres Memorial
13 Interchange". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
14 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

15 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.289 of Title 69, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The bridge over U.S. Highway 266 on U.S. Highway 69 within the
19 municipal limits of Checotah shall be designated as the "Paul Henry
20 Carr Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
21 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
22 highway.

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1 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.290 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of U.S. Highway 77 beginning at the south edge of
5 the municipal limits of Marietta extending southwesterly to the
6 northern municipal limits of Thackerville in Love County shall be
7 designated as the "Trooper Leon H. Brown Memorial Highway". The
8 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
9 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.291 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The bridge over Interstate 35 on 4th Street within the municipal
14 limits of Moore shall be designated as the "1LT Damon Leehan
15 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
16 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
17 highway.

18 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.292 of Title 69, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The portion of State Highway 82 beginning at the junction of
22 State Highway 82 and West Gideon Road in Cherokee County extending
23 southeast to the junction of State Highway 82 and North Elm Grove
24 Road in Cherokee County shall be designated as the "Deputy Sean

1 Cookson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
2 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
3 the highway.

4 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.293 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The bridge over Martin Luther King Avenue on Interstate 44
8 within the municipal limits of Oklahoma City shall be designated as
9 the "Senator E. Melvin Porter Memorial Bridge". The Department of
10 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
11 name to be placed on the highway.

12 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.294 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The section of State Highway 54 beginning at the Custer County -
16 Washita County line extending southerly to the intersection with
17 State Highway 54B in Washita County shall be designated as the
18 "Deputy Sheriff Clifford Phillip Payne Memorial Highway". The
19 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
20 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

21 SECTION 9. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 307, O.S.L.
22 2018 (69 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 1698.271), is amended to read as
23 follows:

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1 Section 1698.271 The bridge on ~~U.S. Highway 283~~ Interstate 40
2 over the North Fork Red River ~~south of the municipal limits of~~ near
3 the town of Sayre in Beckham County shall be designated as the "SSG
4 Christopher ~~Micheal~~ Michael Hake Memorial Bridge". The Department
5 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing
6 that name to be placed on the bridge.

7 SECTION 10. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
