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11 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 5, line 12 and 1/2, insert new Sections 12,
12 13 and 14 to read

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13 "SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.297 of Title 69, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

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16 The bridge over Big Creek on State Highway 10 located 1.8 miles
17 east of the Craig County line shall be designated as the "Private
18 First Class George Henry Taylor Memorial Bridge". The Department of
19 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
20 name to be placed on the bridge.

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21 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.298 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

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1 The section of State Highway 5 beginning at the intersection of
2 South Boundary Avenue and extending south and easterly to the
3 intersection of N2680 County Road in Cotton County shall be
4 designated as the "City Marshal Jefferson Davis "J.D." Graham
5 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
6 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
7 highway.

8 SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
9 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.299 of Title 69, unless
10 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

11 The section of State Highway 5 west of the municipal limits of
12 Temple beginning on the west side of State Highway 65 South and
13 extending west to the intersection of N2640 County Road in Cotton
14 County shall be designated as the "Sheriff Horace H. "Bill" Dyer
15 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
16 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
17 highway."

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.287 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The bridge over Choctaw Road on U.S. Highway 69 in Bryan County
18 shall be designated as the "Deputy Sheriff Michael Dee Pace Memorial
19 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
20 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

21 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.288 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The interchange of Interstate 40 and Cimarron Road in Canadian
2 County shall be designated as the "Landon L. Endres Memorial
3 Interchange". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
4 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

5 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.289 of Title 69, unless
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 The bridge over U.S. Highway 266 on U.S. Highway 69 within the
9 municipal limits of Checotah shall be designated as the "Paul Henry
10 Carr Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
11 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
12 highway.

13 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.290 of Title 69, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The section of U.S. Highway 77 beginning at the south edge of
17 the municipal limits of Marietta extending southwesterly to the
18 northern municipal limits of Thackerville in Love County shall be
19 designated as the "Trooper Leon H. Brown Memorial Highway". The
20 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
21 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

22 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.291 of Title 69, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The bridge over Interstate 35 on 4th Street within the municipal
2 limits of Moore shall be designated as the "1LT Damon Leehan
3 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
4 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
5 highway.

6 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.292 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The portion of State Highway 82 beginning at the junction of
10 State Highway 82 and West Gideon Road in Cherokee County extending
11 southeast to the junction of State Highway 82 and North Elm Grove
12 Road in Cherokee County shall be designated as the "Deputy Sean
13 Cookson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
14 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
15 the highway.

16 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.293 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The bridge over Martin Luther King Avenue on Interstate 44
20 within the municipal limits of Oklahoma City shall be designated as
21 the "Senator E. Melvin Porter Memorial Bridge". The Department of
22 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
23 name to be placed on the highway.

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1 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.294 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of State Highway 54 beginning at the Custer County -
5 Washita County line extending southerly to the intersection with
6 State Highway 54B in Washita County shall be designated as the
7 "Deputy Sheriff Clifford Phillip Payne Memorial Highway". The
8 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
9 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 9. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 307, O.S.L.
11 2018 (69 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 1698.271), is amended to read as
12 follows:

13 Section 1698.271 The bridge on ~~U.S. Highway 283~~ Interstate 40
14 over the North Fork Red River ~~south of the municipal limits of~~ near
15 the town of Sayre in Beckham County shall be designated as the "SSG
16 Christopher ~~Michael~~ Michael Hake Memorial Bridge". The Department
17 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing
18 that name to be placed on the bridge.

19 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.295 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The section of State Highway 18 beginning at Lone Chimney Road
23 extending north to the intersection with State Highway 64 in Pawnee
24 County shall be designated as the "Undersheriff Monty Johnson

1 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
2 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
3 highway.

4 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.296 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The section of U.S. Highway 64 Business beginning at West 23rd
8 Street South extending north to the intersection of West Southside
9 Blvd. in the City of Muskogee in Muskogee County shall be designated
10 as the "Councilwoman Avalon Reese Memorial Highway". The Department
11 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing
12 that name to be placed on the highway.

13 SECTION 12. AMENDATORY Section 5, Chapter 246, O.S.L.
14 2018 (69 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 1698.281), is amended to read as
15 follows:

16 Section 1698.281 The portion of U.S. Highway 69 beginning at
17 the junction of U.S. Highway 69 and W. Shawnee Street in Muskogee
18 County extending north to the junction of U.S. Highway 69 and W.
19 Fern Mountain Road in Muskogee County shall be designated as the
20 "Tuskegee Airman 2nd Lt Faythe McGinnis Memorial Highway". The
21 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
22 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

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1 SECTION 13. AMENDATORY Section 12, Chapter 372, O.S.L.
2 2013, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 61, O.S.L. 2015 (69 O.S.
3 Supp. 2018, Section 1600.1), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1600.1 Highways, bridges, and other facilities which
5 are part of the state highway system may be considered for
6 dedication in honor of individuals deserving of commendation for
7 their active involvement in the project or for outstanding service
8 to the nation, this state, or their community. ~~Persons proposed to~~
9 ~~be so honored shall have been deceased not less than three (3) years~~
10 ~~prior to consideration.~~ The provisions of this section shall not
11 apply to the naming of highways and bridges on the state highway
12 system designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces,
13 members of law enforcement or firefighters fallen in the performance
14 of their duties. The provisions of this section shall also not
15 apply to the naming of highways and bridges on the state highway
16 system designed to honor Medal of Honor recipients both living and
17 deceased. Proposals for the dedication of state highway facilities
18 should specifically state the accomplishments upon which the
19 proposal is based.

20 SECTION 14. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
