6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to criminal procedure; requiring the
8 use of audio or audiovisual recording equipment by
9 peace officers while on duty; defining term;
10 providing for codification; and providing an
11 effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 212 of Title 22, unless there is
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Upon the effective date of this act, every law enforcement
17 agency in this state that supplies its peace officers with audio or
18 audiovisual recording equipment shall require its peace officers to
19 use the audio or audiovisual recording equipment at all times while
20 on duty including, but not limited to, when responding to calls for
21 service, during traffic stops, and any time the peace officer
22 interacts with members of the public.

1 B. As used in this section, "audio or audiovisual recording
2 equipment" means an electronic recording device that is capable of
3 recording audio or video with sound.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
