The production 6 7 of oil in the State of Oklahoma in such manner and under such conditions as to constitute waste, as in this act defined in Section 8 9 86.1 et seq. of this title, is hereby prohibited, and the 10 Corporation Commission shall have authority, and is charged with the 11 duty, to make rules, regulations, and orders for the prevention of 12 such waste, and for the protection of all fresh water strata and oil 13 or gas bearing strata encountered in any well drilled for oil or 14 gas.

17	SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma

19	reads as follows:					
20	A. It is the policy of the State of Oklahoma to:					
21	Reduce and recycle oil and gas waste whenever feasible; and					
22	2. Treat in an environmentally safe manner the oil and gas waste that cannot be					
23	reduced or recycled.					

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B. As used in the Oil and Gas Waste Efficiency and Recycling Act, "oil and gas waste" shall mean saltwater, mineral brines, waste oil and other deleterious substances produced from or obtained or used in connection with the drilling, development, producing and operating of oil and gas wells.

SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 318.13 of Title 52, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Corporation Commission shall work in conjunction with the Secretary of Energy and Environment, the Oklahoma Water Resources Board and the Department of Environmental Quality to:

- Implement recommendations of the Water for 2060 Produced Water Working Group as appointed by the Governor;
- 2. Continue developing an energy and industry water-use best-practices guidance and recognition program; and
- 3. Continue promoting and supporting initiatives to increase the use of marginal-quality water supplies in energy and industrial applications.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
