13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 846 of Title 74, unless there is
15	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	Any person applying for employment with the state or any
17	political subdivision of the state shall sign an affidavit of
18	noncollusion stating that the individual is not in collusion with
19	any elected official in Oklahoma to gain employment with the state
20	or a political subdivision of the state.
21	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
