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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 528.8 of Title 57, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. Effective July 1, 2020, all personnel of the Department of
19	Corrections employed by the state on the last working day of June
20	2019:
21	1. At a facility listed in subsection B of this section, or
22	as a probation and parole officer; and
23	2. With a job classification listed in subsection C of this
24	section,

1 shall, subject to reduction as provided in subsection D of this
2 section, be awarded an increase of Two Dollars (\$2.00) per hour over
3 their current hourly wage, or an equivalent amount if not receiving
4 an hourly wage.

5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.
6	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
