SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be

codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

There is hereby appropriated to the Legislative Service Bureau from monies not otherwise appropriated from the Statewide Recovery Fund of the State Treasury created in Enrolled House Bill No. 3349 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Fourteen Thousand One Hundred Ten Dollars (\$14,110.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay obligations that may arise out of contracts during the Fiscal Year 2023 and Fiscal Year 2024 related to the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
