13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2021, Section 4500, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 4500. Gold and silver coins issued by the United States
17	government are legal tender in the State of Oklahoma. No person may
18	compel another person to tender or accept gold or silver coins that
19	are issued by the United States government, except as agreed upon by
20	contract.
21	A. As used in this act:
22	1. "Legal tender" means a recognized medium of exchange for the
23	payment of debts and taxes; and
24	2. "Specie" means:

1	a. coin having gold or silver content, or
2	b. refined gold or silver bullion that is:
3	(1) coined, stamped, or imprinted with its weight,
4	and
5	(2) valued primarily based on its metal content and
6	not its form.
7	B. Specie or legal tender shall consist of:
8	1. Specie coin issued by the United States government; or
9	2. Other specie that an Oklahoma court rules to be within state
10	authority to make or designate as legal tender.
11	C. Specie or legal tender shall not be characterized as
12	personal property for taxation or regulatory purposes.
13	D. 1. The exchange of one type or form of legal tender for
14	another type or form of legal tender shall not give rise to any tax
15	<u>liability.</u>
16	2. The purchase, sale, or exchange of any type or form of
17	specie shall not give rise to any tax liability.
18	E. Unless specifically provided by law or by contract, a person
19	shall not compel another person to tender specie or to accept specie
20	as legal tender.
21	F. The Office of the Attorney General shall enforce this act
22	without prejudice to a private right of action.
23	G. If a valid contract expressly designates a type or form of
24	specie as tender, then an Oklahoma court asked to adjudicate the

1	breach of such a contract shall require, as a remedy for the breach,
2	the specific performance of tendering the type or form of specie
3	specified in the contract.
4	H. Specie may be recognized to pay debts.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
