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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 151, as last
15	amended by Section 5, Chapter 268, O.S.L. 2016 (47 O.S. Supp. 2017,
16	Section 151), is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 151. A. A state agency that owns or leases vehicles
18	shall affix the words "State of Oklahoma" and the name of the
19	department or institution that owns or leases the vehicle in
20	conspicuous letters.
21	B. 1. In lieu of the provisions of subsection A of this
22	section, Department of Public Safety vehicles used regularly as
23	patrol units shall be distinctively painted black and <u>or</u> white and
24	shall bear the wording "Oklahoma Highway Patrol" on each side of the

vehicle in letters of such size as to be easily distinguishable, it being the purpose and intention of the Legislature that said patrol units shall be marked in the future in the same manner as those now in use.

5 2. The Commissioner of Public Safety may designate colors and
6 markings, in lieu of those authorized by the provisions of this
7 section, for patrol units used for patrol purposes and for selective
8 traffic law enforcement.

9 C. Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs 10 Control vehicles for use in undercover investigations and Oklahoma 11 State Bureau of Investigation vehicles shall not be subject to the 12 provisions of this section.

D. Department of Corrections vehicles designated for use by
probation and parole operations and other administrative operations,
as approved by the Director of the Department of Corrections, shall
not be subject to the provisions of this section.

E. Vehicles utilized by CLEET-certified officers or state
employees primarily employed in investigative activities may be
exempt from the provisions of this section subject to the approval
of the State Fleet Manager.

F. Oklahoma Military Department vehicles designated for use by the Adjutant General or Assistant Adjutant General in performance of his or her duties and Oklahoma Military Department vehicles designated for use in the State Transition and Reintegration System

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1	(STARS) program for tracking youth, as approved by the Adjutant
2	General, shall not be subject to the provisions of this section.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
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
