NEW LAW 16 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows: 17 This act shall be known as the "Hobbie Family Act of 2024". 18 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7341 of Title 63, unless there 20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 21 As used in this act: 22 "Housing Rental Facility" means any complex or structure 23 where multiple rental units are located. This includes apartment

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complexes and trailer home rental complexes, including those that

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rent out plots of land to multiple individuals as permanent residents.

- 2. "ICC" means the Interstate Commerce Commission.
- 3. "Tornado Safety Area" means any area deemed suitable to withstand the impact of a tornado by the ICC 500 criteria. This includes underground shelters such as basements and cellars and reinforced above ground shelters.
- SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7342 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

All housing rental facilities must install and maintain a tornado safety area capable of housing at least three-fourths (3/4) of the facility's maximum housing capacity.

- A. If a current tornado safety area exists that meets the three-fourths (3/4) maximum housing capacity criteria, that location will not be required to construct a new safety area.
- B. Compliance inspections will be conducted every year by the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management.
- 1. Additional inspections will be conducted upon receiving a complaint regarding a violation of this law.
- 2. Inspections conducted in conjunction with this law will be funded from the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management fiscal year budget.

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1	SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7343 of Title 63, unless there
3	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
4	A. Any housing rental facility found in violation of this law
5	will be required to pay a fine of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00)
6	in addition to constructing a shelter compliant with ICC 500
7	criteria or cover relocation costs to a compliant facility for all
8	current tenants.
9	B. Fines will be paid to the Oklahoma Department of Emergency
10	Management.
11	SECTION 5. This act shall become effective January 1, 2025.
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
