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8	An Act relating to higher education; creating the Oklahoma Department of Transportation Educational
9	Assistance Act; providing definitions; establishing assistance program for eligible students; clarifying
10	details of assistance; providing criteria for eligibility; requiring repayment under certain
11	circumstances; permitting both public and private funding of program; directing the Department of
12 13	Transportation to promulgate rules; creating the Oklahoma Department of Transportation Educational
13 14	Assistance Revolving Fund; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3234 of Title 70, unless there
20	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
21	A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma
22	Department of Transportation Educational Assistance Act".
23	B. As used in this act:
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1. "Conditional grant program" means the Oklahoma Department of
 2 Transportation Educational Assistance Program established pursuant
 3 to the provisions of this section;

4 2. "Department" means the Oklahoma Department of5 Transportation;

3. "Eligible degree" means a baccalaureate degree from an
institution in a field of study that satisfies the Department's
minimum education requirement for an eligible profession;

9 4. "Eligible profession" means the profession of engineering or
10 another profession as defined by Department rule for which the
11 Department determines there is a need in the Department's workforce;

12 5. "Eligible Student" means a student who has a high school 13 diploma or who has completed General Educational Development (GED) 14 requirements and who:

15a.has completed and filed with the Department, on forms16prescribed by the Department, a conditional grant17application and a declaration of intent to become a18member of an eligible profession and work for the19Department for the five (5) academic years immediately20following the date of the student's receipt of an21eligible degree,

b. has enrolled in an Oklahoma educational institution,and

24 c. is an Oklahoma resident;

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6. "Graduate program" means a program offered by an Oklahoma
 educational institution that leads to the award of a master's
 degree;

4 7. "Oklahoma educational institution" means an institution of
5 higher education within the Oklahoma State System of Higher
6 Education;

8. "Profession" means a state position for which the minimum
requirements include a baccalaureate degree; and

9 9. "Undergraduate program" means a program offered by an
10 Oklahoma educational institution that leads to the award of an
11 associate's degree or a baccalaureate degree.

12 С. There is hereby created the Oklahoma Department of 13 Transportation Educational Assistance Program to provide assistance 14 to eligible students who enroll in an Oklahoma educational 15 institution and who agree to work for the Department in an eligible 16 profession for the five (5) academic years immediately following the 17 date of the student's receipt of an eligible degree. The 18 Department, by rule, shall prescribe criteria for the selection of 19 applicants under this act. Subject to the availability of funds, 20 the amount of assistance shall be equivalent to the amount of 21 resident tuition, mandatory fees, and academic service fees for 22 courses in which the eligible student is enrolled, not to exceed a 23 maximum of eighteen (18) credit hours each semester.

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The amount of assistance provided to an eligible student
 enrolled in an undergraduate program shall not exceed a maximum of
 one hundred twenty (120) credit hours in pursuit of an associate's
 degree and/or a baccalaureate degree;

5 2. Subject to the assistance for eligible students enrolled in 6 undergraduate programs being fully funded, assistance shall be 7 provided to an eligible student with a baccalaureate degree enrolled 8 in a graduate program. The amount of assistance provided to an 9 eligible student enrolled in a graduate program shall not exceed a 10 maximum of forty (40) credit hours in pursuit of a master's degree;

3. Assistance provided pursuant to this section shall be granted without any limitation other than the amount of funds available for the program and the number of eligible students who apply;

4. Assistance allowed by this section shall not be allowed for
courses taken in excess of the requirements for completion of an
undergraduate program or a graduate program, whichever is applicable
for the eligible student;

D. 1. To be eligible to apply for the conditional grant program, an eligible student shall:

a. complete and file with the Department, on forms
prescribed by the Department, a conditional grant
application and a declaration of intent to become a
member of an eligible profession and work for the

24	E. Repayme	ent of Conditional Grant:

The Department, by rule, may establish conditions under
 which a student who has received a conditional grant may be required
 to repay all or part of the grant because the student has withdrawn
 from or dropped out of the student's institution or has otherwise
 failed to maintain eligibility for the grant;

2. A student who does not become a member of an eligible
profession and work for the Department for the five (5) academic
years immediately following the date of the student's receipt of an
eligible degree must repay all conditional grants received by the
student;

An eligible student who has received assistance pursuant to the provisions of this conditional grant program and who fails to comply with the provisions of this act due to hardship circumstances may request a waiver from repayment;

Repayments shall be deposited into the Oklahoma Department
 of Transportation Educational Assistance Revolving Fund created
 pursuant to Section 2 of this act; and

18 5. The Department shall establish a schedule for installment19 payments under this section.

F. The Department may accept gifts and grants from any public or private source for the conditional grant program under this subchapter and may also use for that purpose available money credited to the state highway program. All funding received by the

Department for this purpose shall be transferred to the Oklahoma
 Department of Transportation Educational Assistance Revolving Fund.

G. The Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall promulgaterules to implement the provisions of this act.

5 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3235 of Title 70, unless there 7 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund 8 9 to be designated the "Oklahoma Department of Transportation 10 Educational Assistance Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a 11 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall 12 consist of monies received by the Department and allocated for the 13 conditional grant program. All monies accruing to the credit of the 14 fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the 15 Oklahoma Department of Transportation for the purpose of providing 16 assistance to eligible students pursuant to the provisions of 17 Section 1 of this act. Expenditures from the fund shall be made 18 upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as 19 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and 20 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
