15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 650.12 of Title 21, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	Any person who, without justifiable or excusable cause, commits
20	during the commission of a crime, a battery or an assault and
21	battery upon an employee of the retail establishment while such
22	employee is in the performance of his or her duties shall, upon
23	conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by a term of
24	imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a

1	term not exceeding two (2) years, or by a fine not exceeding Two
2	Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00), or by both such fine and
3	imprisonment.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
