A new section of law to be codified NEW LAW 23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8-114 of Title 70, unless there

is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

- A. Any student who attends a school that is identified in the bottom five percent (5%) of schools in the state, may transfer to another school within his or her resident school district that offers the grade the student is entitled to pursue, regardless of the posted transfer capacity of the school.
- B. A student forfeits his or her right to a transfer pursuant to this section if the student:
- 1. Is found guilty of the acts and reasons outlined in Section 24-101.3 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes that are described as bases for denial of a transfer under paragraph 1 of subsection B of Section 8-101.2 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes; or
- 2. Has a history of absences as defined in paragraph 2 of subsection B of Section 8-101.2 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
 - SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
- SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
