- Oklahoma Senate, the Governor of this state and the Oklahoma
  Secretary of Agriculture:
  - 1. The number of Cooperative Extension Program employees paid with state, federal or county funds;
  - 2. The number of employees of Oklahoma State University primarily working in research related fields or within any facilities, departments or divisions where the primary function is to conduct research;
  - 3. A list of any recommendations received by the Oklahoma Association of Extension Agriculture Agents and the specific recommendations that were implemented or adopted, including an explanation as to why any recommendations were not implemented or adopted;
  - 4. A description of any current plans, policies and procedures to organize and conduct agricultural extension work;
  - 5. A statement providing how any current plans, policies and procedures to organize and conduct agricultural extension work complies with Section 342 of Title 7 of the United States Code; and
  - 6. A statement providing how any current plans, policies and procedures to organize and conduct agricultural extension work complies with findings by the Attorney General pursuant to Op.Atty.Gen. No. 2018-1, March 15, 2018, that individual counties negotiate and enter into contracts with the United States Department of Agriculture and Oklahoma State University for the Extension
