7	A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or
8 9	rejection a proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma by adding a new Section 38 to Article II; guaranteeing the right to engage in
10	certain farming and ranching practices; prohibiting Legislature from passing certain laws; providing for
11	interpretation; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

14	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
15	1ST SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
16	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
17	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
18	the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of
19	Oklahoma by adding a new Section 38 to Article II thereof, to read
20	as follows:
21	Section 38. To protect agriculture as a vital sector of
22	Oklahoma's economy, which provides food, energy, health benefits,
23	and security and is the foundation and stabilizing force of
24	Oklahoma's economy, the rights of farmers and ranchers to engage in

1 farming and ranching practices shall be forever guaranteed in this 2 state. The Legislature shall pass no law which abridges the right 3 of farmers and ranchers to employ agricultural technology and 4 livestock production and ranching practices without a compelling 5 state interest.

Nothing in this section shall be construed to modify any
provision of common law or statutes relating to trespass, eminent
domain, or any other property rights.

 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

15 This measure adds a new section of law to the State

Constitution. It adds Section 38 to Article 2. It protects the rights of farmers and ranchers to engage in farming and ranching practices. It prohibits the Legislature from passing laws that would take away the right to employ agricultural technology and livestock production without a compelling state interest. It
