13	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
14	1ST SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
15	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
16	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
17	the following proposed amendment to Section 1 of Article XXIV of the
18	Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:
19	Section 1. Any amendment or amendments to this Constitution may
20	be proposed in either branch of the Legislature, and if the same
21	shall be agreed to by $\frac{1}{2}$ majority $\frac{1}{2}$ two-thirds $(2/3)$ of all the members
22	elected to each of the two (2) houses, such proposed amendment or
23	amendments shall, with the yeas and nays thereon, be entered in
24	their journals and referred by the Secretary of State to the people

for their approval or rejection, at the next regular general election, except when the Legislature, by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of each house, shall order a special election for that purpose. If a majority of all the electors voting on any proposed amendment at such election shall vote in favor thereof, it shall thereby become a part of this Constitution.

No proposal for the amendment or alteration of this Constitution which is submitted to the voters shall embrace more than one general subject and the voters shall vote separately for or against each proposal submitted; provided, however, that in the submission of proposals for the amendment of this Constitution by articles, which embrace one general subject, each proposed article shall be deemed a single proposal or proposition.

SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in the following form:

THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It would change the number of votes required in the Legislature to send proposed constitutional amendments to a vote of the people. Currently, a simple majority of each house of the Legislature is required for a proposal scheduled for the next general election and a two-
