8 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State
10 to refer to the people for their approval or
11 rejection a proposed amendment to Section 3 of
12 Article 28A of the Oklahoma Constitution; eliminating
the prohibition of refrigerated spirit sales by
retail spirits licensees; providing ballot title; and
directing filing.

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
16 2ND SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

17 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
18 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
19 the following proposed amendment to Section 3 of Article 28A of the
20 Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

21 Section 3. A. The Legislature shall, by law, prescribe a set
22 of licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages to consumers for
23 off-premise consumption, which shall include, but not be limited to:
24

1 1. A Retail Spirits License, which shall be required in order
2 to sell the following:

- 3 a. refrigerated and non-refrigerated spirits in their
4 original sealed package, and/or
- 5 b. refrigerated and non-refrigerated wine and beer in
6 their original sealed package.

7 A holder of a Retail Spirits License shall be permitted to sell
8 at retail any item that may be purchased at a grocery store or
9 convenience store, as defined by law, so long as the sale of items
10 other than alcoholic beverages do not comprise more than twenty
11 percent (20%) of the holder's monthly sales;

12 2. A Retail Wine License, which shall be required in order to
13 sell refrigerated or non-refrigerated wine in the original sealed
14 package. Retail Wine Licenses may be owned without limitation on
15 number by retail locations; and

16 3. A Retail Beer License, which shall be required in order to
17 sell refrigerated or non-refrigerated beer in the original sealed
18 package. Retail Beer Licenses may be owned without limitation on
19 number by retail locations.

20 B. As used in this section, the term "retail location" shall
21 include, but not be limited to:

22 1. Supermarkets, grocery stores, convenience stores, drug
23 stores, warehouse, clubs and supercenters as defined by law; and/or

1 SECTION 2 hereof, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the
2 Attorney General.
