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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Aeronautics
8 Commission; providing for consolidation of the
9 Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission with the Department
10 of Transportation; providing for transfer of funds;
11 providing for transfer of books, papers, records,
12 property, functions, powers, duties and obligations;
13 providing for transfer of personnel; providing for
14 continuation of rules, regulations, acts, orders,
15 determinations and decisions; amending 3 O.S. 2011,
16 Section 91, as last amended by Section 4, Chapter
17 331, O.S.L. 2017 (3 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 91),
18 which relates to the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission
19 Revolving Fund; modifying agency reference; repealing
20 3 O.S. 2011, Section 84.2, which relates to the
21 Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission; providing for
22 codification; and providing an effective date.

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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

26 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
27 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 84.3 of Title 3, unless there is
28 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

29 A. The Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission is hereby consolidated
30 into the Department of Transportation.

1 B. Any funds appropriated to, in the possession of or allocated
2 to the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission shall be deemed to be funds
3 of and shall be transferred to the Department of Transportation.

4 C. All books, papers, records, property, functions, powers,
5 duties and obligations of the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission are
6 hereby transferred to the Department of Transportation.

7 D. All personnel of the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission are
8 hereby transferred to the Department of Transportation.

9 E. All rules, regulations, acts, orders, determinations and
10 decisions pertaining to the functions and powers herein transferred
11 and assigned to the Department of Transportation, in force at the
12 time of such transfer or assignment, shall continue in force and
13 effect until duly modified or abrogated by the Department of
14 Transportation or until otherwise provided by law.

15 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 3 O.S. 2011, Section 91, as last
16 amended by Section 4, Chapter 331, O.S.L. 2017 (3 O.S. Supp. 2017,
17 Section 91), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 91. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
19 revolving fund for the ~~Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission~~ Department of
20 Transportation to be designated as the Oklahoma Aeronautics
21 Commission Revolving Fund. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not
22 subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of a monthly
23 allocation by the Oklahoma Tax Commission of Three Thousand Dollars
24 (\$3,000.00) from the motor fuel excise tax levied and collected

1 pursuant to the provisions of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
2 such amount being a part of the estimated amount of tax paid on
3 gasoline consumed by engines to propel aircraft in Oklahoma, sale of
4 surplus property, fees and receipts collected pursuant to the
5 Oklahoma Open Records Act, donations, gifts, bequests, contribution,
6 devices, interagency reimbursements, federal funds unless otherwise
7 provided by federal law or regulation, sale of leases and aircraft
8 registration fees and taxes, fees authorized by Section 1135.5 of
9 Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes or any other source. All monies
10 accruing to the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and
11 expended by the ~~Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission~~ Department of
12 Transportation for airport construction and rehabilitation programs,
13 general operations of the agency, for promoting the awareness of
14 aviation and aerospace, and providing financial support for aviation
15 education programs to address the need for a skilled and competent
16 aviation workforce. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon
17 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
18 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
19 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

20 SECTION 3. REPEALER 3 O.S. 2011, Section 84.2, is hereby
21 repealed.

22 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
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
