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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 5-113, as
15	amended by Section 1, Chapter 65, O.S.L. 2018 (70 O.S. Supp. 2019,
16	Section 5-113), is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 5-113. A. Except as otherwise provided in this
18	section, no person shall be eligible to be a candidate for or serve
19	on a board of education if the person is currently employed by the
20	school district or a charter school governed by, sponsored by or
21	authorized by that board of education or is related within the
22	second degree by affinity or consanguinity to any other member of
23	the board of education or to any employee of the school district $\underline{\text{or}}$
24	charter school governed by the, sponsored by or authorized by that

1 board of education. The purpose of this section is both to prohibit 2 persons who are related within the second degree by affinity or consanguinity from serving simultaneously on the same board of 3 education of any school district or charter school of this state and 4 5 to prohibit persons who are related within the second degree of consanguinity or affinity to an employee of a school district or 6 7 charter school from serving on the board of education governing, sponsoring or authorizing the school district or charter school 8 9 while such relative is employed except as otherwise provided in this 10 section.

B. If the relationship is based on affinity, the prohibitions in this section shall not apply to prevent members of boards of education who are serving on September 1, 1995, from serving the term for which they were elected or from serving successive terms for which they may be elected, unless it is the member's spouse who is a member of the board of education or an employee of the school district, then such prohibitions shall apply.

18 C. The prohibitions set forth in this section shall not apply 19 if:

The person related to the board member within the second
 degree of affinity or consanguinity is employed as a substitute
 teacher by the school district <u>or charter school</u> pursuant to the
 provisions of Section 6-105 of this title or as a temporary
 substitute support employee if the school district <u>or charter school</u>

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1 has an Average Daily Membership (ADM) of less than five thousand 2 (5,000); or

2. The school district <u>or charter school</u> has an ADM of less than four hundred (400), the board of education has adopted a policy providing for such candidate eligibility and the board member who is related within the second degree by affinity or consanguinity to any employee of the school district <u>or charter school</u> governed by, <u>sponsored by or authorized by</u> the board of education complies with the provisions of subsection E of Section 5-113.1 of this title.

D. Any member of a board of education who violates the provisions of this section shall be subject to the penalties prescribed by Sections 485 and 486 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

Section 5-113.1. A. Except as otherwise provided in this 17 section, no person may be employed or put under contract by a school 18 district or a charter school if that person is related to a member 19 of the board of education of that governs, sponsors or authorizes 20 that school district or charter school within the second degree of 21 consanguinity or affinity. A teacher or employee already under 22 contract to or otherwise employed by the school district or charter 23 school at the time the relationship is established may continue in 24

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1 said <u>the</u> employment. Except as otherwise provided, a board member 2 already serving at the time the relationship is established may 3 serve out the term for which the member was elected but shall not be 4 eligible to be a candidate for or serve successive terms of office 5 for which the member may be elected.

The provisions of this section shall not prevent a board 6 Β. member from serving successive terms of office if otherwise eligible 7 under the provision of Section 5-113 of this title. No member of 8 9 the board of education who has resigned from the board before the 10 term of the person has expired may be reappointed to the board to 11 complete the remainder of the term if a teacher or employee of a 12 school district or a charter school related to the resigned member of the board that governs, sponsors or authorizes the school 13 district or charter school within the second degree of consanguinity 14 15 or affinity was put under contract or otherwise employed by the 16 school district or charter school after the board member resigned. The provisions of this section shall not prevent a person С. 17 who is related to a member of the board of education that governs, 18 sponsors or authorizes the school district or charter school within 19 the second degree of consanguinity or affinity from being employed 20 by the school district or charter school as a substitute teacher 21

3 The provisions of this section shall not prevent a person D. who is related to a member of the board of education that governs, 4 5 sponsors or authorizes the school district or charter school within the second degree of consanguinity or affinity from being employed 6 by the school district or charter school if the school district or 7 charter school has an Average Daily Membership (ADM) of less than 8 9 four hundred (400) and the board of education has adopted a policy 10 providing for such employment.

Any member of a board of education that governs, sponsors or 11 Ε. 12 authorizes the school district or charter school who is related to a teacher or other employee of the district or charter school within 13 the second degree of consanguinity or affinity shall not attend or 14 participate in any regular or executive session of the board held to 15 consider any personnel matter or litigation relating to said the 16 17 teacher or employee. The member may vote on collective bargaining agreements or the renewal of contracts as a group if the vote is 18 necessary to form a quorum of the board of education members. 19 Ιf more than one member of the board of education is related to a 20 teacher or employee, only the minimum number of those members which 21 is necessary to form a quorum shall be allowed to vote. Each board 22 of education so affected shall adopt a written policy establishing 23

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1	procedures on when such a member may vote on the renewal of
2	contracts or collective bargaining agreements.
3	F. Any member of a board of education who violates the
4	provisions of this section shall be subject to the penalties
5	prescribed by Sections 485 and 486 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
6	Statutes.
7	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.
8	SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
10	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
