4 to the Energy Resources Revolving Fund; providing
5 that certain funds be deposited in fund; providing
6 for codification; and providing an effective date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1127, as
7 last amended by Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill No. 3192 of the 2nd
8 Session of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as
9 follows:

10 Section 1127. A. 1. All vehicles owned by:

11 a. members of the Armed Forces of the United States
12 assigned to duty in this state in compliance with
13 official military or naval orders, or their spouses,

14 b. members of the Reserve Corps of the Armed Forces of
15 the United States assigned to duty in this state in
16 compliance with official military or naval orders, or
17 their spouses, and

18 c. members of the Oklahoma National Guard or their
19 spouses assigned to duty in this state or in
20 compliance with official military or naval orders, or
21 owned by

22 d. the spouse, who resides in Oklahoma, of a member of
23 the Armed Forces of the United States serving in a
24 foreign country,

1 which ~~vehicles~~ are not being used in a trade or business or for any
2 commercial purpose, are hereby classified specially for vehicle
3 license and registration purposes in this state.

4 2. Any such vehicle described in paragraph 1 of this
5 subsection, which is not registered and licensed for the current
6 year in the state of residence or domicile of the service member,
7 ~~Guardman, or~~ Reservist, member of the Guard or of the spouse owning
8 the vehicle must be registered for the current year in Oklahoma as
9 herein provided, except that any such vehicle which has been
10 licensed in some other state by such service member, ~~Guardman,~~
11 Reservist, member of the Guard or spouse while the service member,
12 ~~Guardman, or~~ Reservist or member of the Guard was stationed in the
13 other state may be operated in this state for the remainder of the
14 year or period for which it is licensed. If such vehicle currently
15 is registered with the Armed Forces of the United States rather than
16 being registered in a state and the service member, ~~Guardman, or~~
17 Reservist or member of the Guard is transferred to a duty station
18 within this state pursuant to military orders, the service member,
19 ~~Guardman,~~ Reservist, member of the Guard or spouse owning the
20 vehicle shall not be required to register the vehicle in this state
21 for a period of thirty (30) days after the date the service member,
22 ~~Guardman, or~~ Reservist or member of the Guard is required to report
23 for duty pursuant to the military.

24

1 3. The service member, ~~Guardman,~~ Reservist, member of the
2 Guard or spouse applying for the registration of any such vehicle
3 described in paragraph 1 of this subsection shall submit an
4 appropriate statement, to be attached to the vehicle registration
5 application, showing the following: A description of the vehicle
6 owned by the applicant; the state and address of the applicant's
7 legal residence or domicile; and that the applicant or applicant's
8 spouse ~~is on active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States~~
9 ~~assigned or stationed at a named location in compliance with~~
10 ~~official military orders~~ meets the eligibility requirements
11 established in paragraph 1 of this subsection. The statement shall
12 be signed by the applicant and certified to by a proper officer of
13 the organization to which the service member, ~~Guardman,~~ or
14 Reservist or member of the Guard is assigned for duty. Provided, in
15 lieu of certification by an officer, the applicant may submit copies
16 of written orders documenting that the service member, ~~Guardman,~~ or
17 Reservist or member of the Guard is on active duty at the time of
18 application for registration. The application shall be accompanied
19 by a registration fee of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00).

20 B. Any Oklahoma resident who is stationed out of state due to
21 an official assignment of the Armed Forces of the United States or
22 their spouse shall be entitled to register his or her vehicle or
23 vehicles in this state for the same registration fee afforded
24 members of the Armed Forces of the United States assigned to duty in

1 this state pursuant to subsection A of this section. Such Oklahoma
2 resident or their spouse who is stationed out of state due to an
3 official assignment of the Armed Forces of the United States shall
4 be exempt from the vehicle inspection requirements of Section 1105
5 of this title; provided, such Oklahoma resident or his or her spouse
6 who is stationed out of state presents valid documentation
7 acceptable to the Oklahoma Tax Commission evidencing that such
8 inspection has been made by an out-of-state authority acceptable to
9 the Tax Commission.

10 Any Oklahoma resident who is stationed out of state due to an
11 official assignment of the Armed Forces of the United States may
12 authorize a designated representative to register his or her vehicle
13 or vehicles as provided for in this subsection if the service
14 member, ~~Guardman, or~~ Reservist or member of the Guard is not able
15 to register the vehicle at the appropriate time.

16 C. Any Oklahoma resident who is a member of the Armed Forces of
17 the United States, Reserve Corps of the Armed Forces of the United
18 States or the Oklahoma National Guard stationed outside of the state
19 due to official assignment of the Armed Forces of the United States,
20 or his or her spouse, shall be exempt from the penalties assessed
21 pursuant to paragraph 4 of subsection C of Section 1115, subsection
22 F of Section 1132 and subsection C of Section 1151 of this title for
23 the duration of such official assignment and for a period of sixty
24 (60) days after such assignment ends. If registration is not

1 completed after the sixtieth day, the expiration date and the period
2 for assessment of penalties shall commence on the sixty-first day.
3 The exemption provided for in this section shall be granted only if
4 the service member, ~~Guardsman,~~ Reservist, member of the Guard or
5 spouse registering such vehicle submits an appropriate statement, to
6 be attached to the vehicle registration application, showing the
7 following: A description of the vehicle owned by the applicant; the
8 state and address of the applicant's legal residence or domicile;
9 and that the applicant or applicant's spouse is on active duty in
10 the Armed Forces of the United States assigned or stationed at a
11 named location outside the state in compliance with official
12 military orders. The statement shall be signed by the applicant and
13 certified to by a proper officer of the organization to which the
14 service member, ~~Guardsman,~~ or Reservist or member of the Guard is
15 assigned for duty. Provided, in lieu of certification by an
16 officer, the applicant may submit copies of written orders
17 documenting that the service member, ~~Guardsman,~~ or Reservist or
18 member of the Guard is on active duty at the time of application for
19 registration.

20 D. ~~The~~ Unless provided otherwise in this section, the reduced
21 registration fee provided herein shall not apply to vehicles owned
22 by retired members of the Armed Forces, inactive members of the
23 Reserve Corps of the Armed Forces, inactive members of the Oklahoma
24

1 National Guard and other members and former members of the Armed
2 Forces of the United States who are not on active duty

3 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as
4 last amended by Section 12, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
5 2015, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

6 Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
7 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
8 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
9 provided by this section.

10 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
11 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
12 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
13 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
14 registered for the current year.

15 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
16 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
17 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
18 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
19 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
20 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
21 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
22 amateur radio operator license plates.

23 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
24 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept

1 applications for special license plates authorized under this
2 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
3 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
4 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
5 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
6 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
7 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
8 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
9 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
10 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

11 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
12 follows:

13 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
15 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war
16 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
17 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war
18 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having
19 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
20 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
21 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
22 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war
23 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
24 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special

1 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
2 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
3 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

4 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
5 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
6 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
7 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
8 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

9 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
11 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
12 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
13 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

14 4. United States Armed Forces License Plates - such plates
15 shall be designed for active, retired, former or reserve members of
16 the United States Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of
17 service, and carry the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air
18 Force, Marines or Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to
19 which the member belongs or did belong. Former members who have
20 been dishonorably discharged shall not be eligible for such plates.
21 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of present
22 or past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services
23 Identity Card or the United States Department of Defense Form ~~(DD)~~
24 214. Retired or former members who are eligible for such plates

1 shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but
2 shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

3 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
4 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
5 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
6 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
7 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
8 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

9 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
11 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
12 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
13 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
14 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
15 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
16 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
17 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
18 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in
19 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
20 of one (1) ton or less;

21 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper
23 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
24 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such

1 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
2 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate
3 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
4 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
5 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not
6 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
7 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
8 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
9 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee
10 provided by this section for special license plates;

11 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
13 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
14 the United States as being:

- 15 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
16 7, 1941,
- 17 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
18 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
19 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
20 exceed three (3) miles, and
- 21 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
22 States Armed Forces.

1 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
2 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
3 less;

4 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
5 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
6 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
7 States as being:

- 8 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
9 of 1945,
- 10 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
11 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
- 12 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
13 States Armed Forces.

14 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each
15 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

16 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall
17 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and
18 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the
19 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."
20 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such
21 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other
22 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the
23 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of
24 registration after the initial issue;

1 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
3 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
4 the United States as being:

5 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
6 1944,

7 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
8 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
9 participation cannot be verified by the United States
10 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
11 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
12 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
13 the person applying for the license plate, and

14 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
15 States Armed Forces.

16 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
17 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

18 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
20 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse
21 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
22 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
23 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
24 was killed in action and that the person making the application is

1 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
2 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
3 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
4 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
5 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
6 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
7 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

8 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
10 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply
11 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification
12 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making
13 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent
14 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two
15 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one
16 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
17 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
18 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
19 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

20 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
22 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the
23 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or
24 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a

1 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated
2 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
5 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such
6 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
7 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

8 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal
10 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police
11 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
12 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council
13 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may
14 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated
15 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of
16 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common
17 education police department by either an identification card or
18 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma
19 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for
20 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial
21 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of
22 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in
23 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;
24 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design

1 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
2 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

3 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
5 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
6 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
7 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
8 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
9 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may
10 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
11 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

12 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
13 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
14 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
15 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps,
16 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which
17 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate
18 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at
19 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.
20 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words
21 "WORLD WAR II";

22 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
24 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be

1 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
2 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
3 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June
4 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former
5 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for
6 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

7 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
8 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
9 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
10 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
11 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
12 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
13 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
14 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
15 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

16 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
18 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
19 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
20 be produced upon application;

21 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
23 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
24 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a

1 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
2 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
3 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the
4 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and
5 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
6 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
7 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
8 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
9 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
10 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

11 20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall
12 be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any
13 resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars
14 organization in this state. Such persons may apply for Veterans of
15 Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a Veterans
16 of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed
17 in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization;

18 21. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed
19 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
20 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and
21 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
22 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
23 of one (1) ton or less;

24

1 22. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
3 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may
4 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle
5 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

6 23. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
7 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
8 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
9 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

10 24. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
12 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
13 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
14 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
15 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

16 25. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed
17 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for
18 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-
19 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
20 the Ninety-Nines;

21 26. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall
22 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.
23 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend
24 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the

1 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".
2 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate
3 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
4 less;

5 27. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall
6 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
7 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United
8 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat
9 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
10 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

11 28. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
13 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
14 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
15 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

16 29. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
18 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
19 United States Secretary of Defense;

20 30. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
22 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any
23 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as
24 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such

1 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
2 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 31. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed
4 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate
5 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the
6 district number;

7 32. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United
9 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
10 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
11 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which
12 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been
13 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a
14 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the
15 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability
16 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons
17 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license
18 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no
19 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying
20 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any
21 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or
22 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or
23 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and
24 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans

1 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one
2 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
3 fee provided by this section for the special license plate
4 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
5 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
6 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this
7 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

8 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
9 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the
10 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be
11 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also
12 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized
13 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled
14 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the
15 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
16 the Tax Commission;

17 33. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such
18 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force
19 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show
20 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be
21 designed in consultation with the Association;

22 34. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
23 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
24 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons

1 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
2 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
3 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
4 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
5 Academy;

6 35. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall
7 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's
8 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal
9 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor
10 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been
11 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.
12 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle
13 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such
14 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax
15 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have
16 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call
17 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications
18 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All
19 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on
20 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for
21 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee
22 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other
23 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant
24 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license

1 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio
2 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall
3 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any
4 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The
5 right to such special identification plates herein provided for
6 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the
7 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

8 36. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for
10 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license
11 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of
12 Oklahoma;

13 37. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or
15 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for
16 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or
17 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county
18 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the
19 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which
20 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension.
21 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
22 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
23 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be

24

1 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this
2 state;

3 38. Gold Star Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of
5 qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran"
6 shall mean:

7 a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
8 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
9 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result
10 of the performance of duties for any branch of the
11 United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard
12 while on active military duty, or

13 b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
14 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
15 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of
16 injury, illness or disease caused by the performance
17 of such duties while on active duty, whether the death
18 occurred while on active duty or after the honorable
19 discharge of such person.

20 The fee provided by this section for the special license plate
21 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
22 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
23 levied by Section 1132 of this title;

24

1 39. Korea Defense Service Medal License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who has
3 been awarded the Korea Defense Service Medal by the United States
4 Secretary of Defense. Such persons may apply for a Korea Defense
5 Service Medal license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
6 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

7 40. 180th Infantry License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed for members and prior members of the 180th Infantry.
9 Persons applying for such license plate must obtain and provide
10 proof of their membership from the 180th Infantry Association. The
11 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 180th
12 Infantry;

13 41. Operation Iraqi Freedom Veteran License Plates - such
14 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
15 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in
16 Operation Iraqi Freedom. Such person may apply for an Operation
17 Iraqi Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated
18 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

19 42. United States Air Force Academy Alumni License Plates -
20 such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this
21 state who is an alumnus of the United States Air Force Academy.
22 Such persons may apply for a United States Air Force Academy Alumnus
23 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
24 (1) ton or less;

1 43. Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran License ~~Plate~~ Plates -
2 such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged
3 or present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in
4 Operation Enduring Freedom on or after September 11, 2001. The
5 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military
6 Department of the State of Oklahoma. Such person may apply for an
7 Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle
8 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

9 44. Military Multi-Decoration License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such
10 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
11 present member of the United States Armed Forces who qualifies for
12 more than one military decoration license plate pursuant to the
13 provisions of this section. The Tax Commission shall develop and
14 implement a system whereby the designs of the eligible license
15 plates can be included together on a single license plate. Such
16 person may apply for a Military Multi-Decoration license plate for
17 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

18 45. Global War on Terror Expeditionary License ~~Plate~~ Plates -
19 such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged
20 or present member of the United States Armed Forces who has earned a
21 Global War on Terror Expeditionary decoration. The license plate
22 shall be designed in consultation with the United States Institute
23 of Heraldry and the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma.
24 Such person may apply for a Global War on Terror Expeditionary

1 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
2 (1) ton or less;

3 46. Legion of Merit Medal Recipient License Plates - such
4 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state presenting
5 proper certification from the United States Department of Veterans
6 Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that
7 such resident has been awarded the Legion of Merit military
8 decoration. Such persons may apply for a Legion of Merit recipient
9 license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one
10 (1) ton or less. The license plate shall be designed in
11 consultation with the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma;

12 47. 1-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
13 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or
14 former member of the 1-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such
15 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership
16 association with the 1-179th Infantry Association. The license
17 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 1-179th Infantry;

18 48. 2-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
19 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or
20 former member of the 2-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such
21 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership
22 association with the 2-179th Infantry Association. The license
23 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 2-179th Infantry;

1 49. Combat Action Ribbon Recipient License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Ribbon
3 who present proper certification from the United States Department
4 of the Navy. The license plate shall include the Combat Action
5 Ribbon earned by the recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat
6 Action Ribbon Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated
7 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

8 50. Oklahoma Submarine Veterans License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such
9 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who is a
10 United States submarine veteran and presents either a Department of
11 Defense ~~form~~ Form DD 214 or other documentation certifying such
12 service. Such persons may apply for an Oklahoma Submarine Veterans
13 license plate for vehicles having a rated capacity of one (1) ton or
14 less. The license plate design shall include both gold and silver
15 dolphins to represent both officer and enlisted service members; ~~and~~

16 51. United States Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps License
17 ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
18 honorably discharged or present member of the United States Navy
19 Seabees or Civil Engineer Corps. Such persons may apply for a
20 United States Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps license plate
21 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
22 less. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with the
23 Military Department of the State of Oklahoma;

24

1 52. United States Coast Guard Auxiliary License Plates - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
3 present member of the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary. Such
4 persons may apply for a United States Coast Guard Auxiliary license
5 plate for a vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
6 or less. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with
7 the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma;

8 53. United States Public Health Service License Plates - such
9 plates shall be designed and issued to any member of the United
10 States Public Health Service Commissioned Corps. Such persons may
11 apply for a United States Public Health Service license plate for a
12 vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
13 The license plates shall contain the seal or logo of the United
14 States Public Health Service; and

15 54. United States Public Health Service Retired License Plates
16 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired member of
17 the United States Public Health Service Commissioned Corps. Such
18 persons may apply for a United States Public Health Service Retired
19 license plate for a vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one
20 (1) ton or less. The license plate shall contain the seal or logo
21 of the United States Public Health Service.

22 C. Unless otherwise provided by this section, the fee for such
23 plates shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to
24 all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License

1 and Registration Act. Such fees shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
2 Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration
3 of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.

4 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as
5 last amended by Section 23 of Enrolled House Bill No. 3201 of the
6 2nd Session of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as
7 follows:

8 Section 1135.3. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
9 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
10 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or
11 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other
12 subject as provided by this section.

13 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
14 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
15 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
16 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
17 registered for the current year.

18 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
19 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
20 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
21 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
22 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
23 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
24 issued on a staggered system.

1 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
2 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
3 applications for special license plates authorized under this
4 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
5 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
6 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
7 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
8 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
9 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
10 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
11 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
12 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

13 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
14 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
15 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
16 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
17 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
18 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
19 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
20 removed from the vehicle.

21 Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special
22 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special
23 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission
24 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications

1 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax
2 Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective
3 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null
4 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are
5 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
6 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

7 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
8 follows:

9 1. Round and Square Dance License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
11 round and square dancing;

12 2. National Association for the Advancement of Colored People
13 License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to the
14 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the NAACP, and
15 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

16 3. National Rifle Association License Plates - such plates
17 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the
18 Tax Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any
19 person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle
20 Association;

21 4. Masonic Fraternity License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
23 a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a
24 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated

1 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic
2 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for
3 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the
4 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in
5 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall
6 contain the Masonic emblem;

7 5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License
8 Plates - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for
9 Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be
10 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's
11 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in
12 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall
13 contain the Shriner's emblem;

14 6. Balloonists License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
16 hot air ballooning in this state;

17 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plates - such plates shall
18 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member
19 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an
20 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a
21 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
22 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an
23 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
24 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate

1 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
2 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

3 8. Knights of Columbus License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
5 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of
6 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
7 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus
8 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights
9 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
10 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
11 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
12 Columbus emblem;

13 9. Jaycees License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
14 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
15 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
16 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

17 10. Ducks Unlimited License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
19 Ducks Unlimited. The license plates shall be designed in
20 consultation with Ducks Unlimited;

21 11. Kiwanis International License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
23 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in
24

1 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
2 consultation with Kiwanis International;

3 12. Certified Public Accountants License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
5 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified
6 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated
7 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a
8 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed
9 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public
10 Accountants;

11 13. Civil Emergency Management License Plates - such plates
12 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate
13 support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons
14 applying for such license plate must show proof of official
15 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment,
16 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or
17 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state
18 emergency management department head;

19 14. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plates - such plates
20 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
21 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and
22 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian
23 Conservation Corps;

24

1 15. Rotarian License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
2 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian
3 Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license
4 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
5 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the
6 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate
7 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license
8 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian
9 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

10 16. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks License Plates - such
11 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
12 Tax Commission, by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and
13 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of the
14 Benevolent Protective Order of Elks;

15 17. Humane Society License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
17 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued
18 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
19 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
20 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

21 18. Oklahoma Mustang Club License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
23 by the Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this
24 state who is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons

1 may apply for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon
2 presentment of proof of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club.
3 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
4 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
5 personalized license plates;

6 19. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plates - such
7 plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business
8 Clubs. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of
9 membership in AMBUCS. The license plates shall be designed in
10 consultation with American Business Clubs;

11 20. West Point 200th Anniversary License Plates - such plates
12 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
13 the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the United States
14 Military Academy at West Point, New York. The license plates shall
15 be designed in consultation with the West Point Society of Central
16 Oklahoma;

1 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
2 last amended by Section 25 of Enrolled House Bill No. 3201 of the
3 2nd Session of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as
4 follows:

5 Section 1135.5. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
6 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
7 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
8 financial assistance as provided by this section.

9 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
10 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
11 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
12 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
13 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

14 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
15 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
16 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
17 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
18 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
19 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
20 issued on a staggered system.

21 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
22 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
23 applications for special license plates authorized under this
24 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's

1 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
2 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
3 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
4 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
5 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
6 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
7 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
8 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

9 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
10 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
11 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
12 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
13 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
14 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
15 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
16 removed from the vehicle.

17 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
18 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
19 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
20 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
21 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
22 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
23 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
24

1 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
2 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

3 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
4 follows:

5 1. University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
6 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
7 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
8 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
9 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

10 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
11 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
12 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
13 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
14 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
15 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
16 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
18 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
19 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
20 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
21 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
22 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
23 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
24

1 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
2 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

3 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed
4 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.

5 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
6 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
7 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
8 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
9 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
10 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
11 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
12 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
13 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
14 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
15 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
16 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
17 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
18 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

19 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
20 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
21 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
22 the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and Living Memorial;

23 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax

1 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
2 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
3 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
4 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
5 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
6 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
7 plates.

8 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
9 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
10 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

11 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
13 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
14 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
15 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
16 the prevention of child abuse.

17 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
18 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

19 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -
20 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
21 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
22 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
23 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
24 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States

1 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
2 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
3 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
4 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
5 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
6 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
7 issued;

8 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
10 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
11 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
12 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

13 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
15 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected

23 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited

1 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in

4 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
5 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
6 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
7 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
8 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
9 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
10 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
11 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical ~~Technician~~
12 Personnel Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2
13 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

14 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
16 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
17 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
18 Revolving Fund;

19 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
20 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate

22 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
23 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
24 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for

1 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
2 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
3 provide services to crime victims;

4 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates
5 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
6 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
7 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
8 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
9 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
10 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
11 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

12 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
13 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
14 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
15 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
16 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
17 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
18 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
19 Section 1104.4 of this title;

20 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
21 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
22 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
23 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
24 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag

1 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an
2 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
3 Section 1104.3 of this title;

4 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates
5 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
6 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
7 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
8 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
9 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
10 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
11 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
12 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

13 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
15 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
16 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
17 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
18 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
19 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
20 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
21 follows:

22 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
23 Reform Revolving Fund,

13 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.
14 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
15 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
16 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts
17 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
18 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
19 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

20 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such
21 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
22 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
23 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
24 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and

1 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
2 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
3 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
4 of this title;

5 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates
6 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
7 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
8 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
9 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
10 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
11 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
12 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

14 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of
15 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
16 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive

19 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
20 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human

24 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association

1 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
2 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
3 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
4 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
5 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

6 26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
8 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
9 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
10 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
11 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
12 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
13 Section 1104.8 of this title;

14 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
15 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
16 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
17 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
18 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
19 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
20 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
21 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
22 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
23 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
24 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The

1 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts

22 Television Authority Revolving Fund created in Section 156 of Title

1 60. Remembering Fallen Heroes License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
3 demonstrate support for Concerns of Police Survivors, Inc. Such
4 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma chapter
5 of Concerns of Police Survivors, Inc. As provided in this section,
6 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
7 Concerns of Police Survivors License Plate Revolving Fund created in
8 Section 1104.27 of this title.

3 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Dental Association Mission of
4 Mercy. Such plates shall be designed in consultation with the
5 Oklahoma Dental Association. As provided in this section, an amount
6 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Dental
7 Association Mission of Mercy License Plate Revolving Fund created in
8 Section 6 of this act;

9 68. Disabled American Veterans License Plates - such plates
10 shall be designed in consultation with the Disabled American
11 Veterans Department of Oklahoma and issued to any member of the
12 organization wishing to demonstrate support. The Tax Commission
13 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the
14 Disabled American Veterans Department of Oklahoma for any licensing
15 fees which may be required in order to use the organization's logo
16 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
17 the Disabled American Veterans Department of Oklahoma of not more
18 than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued. The
19 plates shall incorporate a numbering system agreed upon by the
20 Disabled American Veterans Department of Oklahoma and the Tax
21 Commission;

22 69. Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plates - such
23 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to increase awareness
24 of those who are currently prisoners of war or missing in action and

1 provide financial support for current veterans. The license plates
2 shall be designed in consultation with Rolling Thunder Oklahoma. As
3 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
4 deposited in the Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate
5 Revolving Fund created in Section 4 of this act;

6 70. John Rex Charter Elementary School License Plates - such
7 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
8 demonstrate support for John Rex Charter Elementary School. Such
9 plates shall be designed in consultation with the administration of
10 John Rex Charter Elementary School. The Tax Commission shall be
11 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with John Rex Charter
12 Elementary School for any licensing fees which may be required in
13 order to use the school's logo or design. The licensing agreement
14 shall provide for a payment to the John Rex Charter Elementary
15 School of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
16 plate issued;

17 71. Jenks Trojans License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
19 the Jenks School District. The license plates shall be designed in
20 consultation with the administration of the Jenks School District.
21 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
22 agreement with the Jenks School District for any licensing fees
23 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
24 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the

1 Jenks School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
2 each license plate issued;

3 72. Bixby Spartans License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
5 the Bixby School District. The license plates shall be designed in
6 consultation with the administration of the Bixby School District.
7 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
8 agreement with the Bixby School District for any licensing fees
9 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
10 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
11 Bixby School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
12 each license plate issued;

13 73. Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation License Plates - such plates
14 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
15 support for the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation. Such plates shall be
16 designed in consultation with the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation.
17 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
18 agreement with the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation for any licensing
19 fees which may be required in order to use the foundation's logo or
20 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
21 Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation of not more than Twenty Dollars
22 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

23 74. Western Heights Public Schools License Plates - such plates
24 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate

1 support for the Western Heights School District. The license plates
2 shall be designed in consultation with the administration of the
3 Western Heights School District. The Tax Commission shall be
4 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Western
5 Heights School District for any licensing fees which may be required
6 in order to use the school district's logo or design. The licensing
7 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Western Heights School
8 District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
9 plate issued;

10 75. Former Oklahoma House Member License Plates - such plates
11 shall be designed and issued to any person who previously served as
12 a member of the Oklahoma House of Representatives. The license
13 plates shall be designed in consultation with Friends of the
14 Oklahoma House of Representatives, Inc. The Tax Commission shall be
15 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with Friends of the
16 Oklahoma House of Representatives, Inc. for any licensing fees which
17 may be required in order to use the logo or design of Friends of the
18 Oklahoma House of Representatives, Inc. The licensing agreement
19 shall provide for a payment to Friends of the Oklahoma House of
20 Representatives, Inc. of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
21 each license plate issued. The Tax Commission shall create and
22 maintain a list of former members of the Oklahoma House of
23 Representatives eligible to be issued such plates. The Tax
24 Commission shall confer as needed with the Chief Clerk of the

1 Oklahoma House of Representatives to confirm that such list is
2 complete and accurate; and

3 76. Oklahoma License to Educate License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
5 support for Oklahoma educators and such plates shall be designed in
6 consultation with the State Department of Education; provided, such
7 plates shall not be designed and issued unless House Bill No. 2951
8 of the 2nd Session of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature becomes law. As
9 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
10 deposited in the Oklahoma Teacher Recruitment Revolving Fund created
11 in Enrolled House Bill No. 2951 of the 2nd Session of the 55th
12 Oklahoma Legislature.

13 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
14 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees

17 Nature Conservancy to fund the Conservancy's operations in this
18 state. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
19 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
20 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
21 Services for approval and payment.

22 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.29 of Title 47, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section
2 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for Piedmont Education
3 Foundation license plates shall be deposited to the Piedmont Public
4 Schools Education Foundation License Plate Revolving Fund created in
5 subsection B of this section.

6 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
7 fund for the State Department of Education to be designated the
8 "Piedmont Public Schools Education Foundation License Plate
9 Revolving Fund". The fund shall consist of all monies received
10 pursuant to subsection A of this section. All monies accruing to
11 the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted
12 and expended by the State Department of Education for grants to the
13 Piedmont Public Schools Education Foundation to fund scholarships
14 and teacher grants to Piedmont Public School District's students and
15 teachers. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
16 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
17 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
18 Services for approval and payment.

19 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.30 of Title 47, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section
23 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for Prisoner of War and
24 Missing in Action license plates shall be deposited to the Prisoner

1 of War and Missing in Action Revolving Fund created in subsection B
2 of this section.

3 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
4 fund for the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs to be
5 designated the "Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate
6 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject
7 to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received
8 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs pursuant to
9 subsection A of this section. All monies accruing to the credit of
10 the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by
11 the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs for the purpose of
12 assisting Oklahoma veterans in need. Expenditures from the fund
13 shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against
14 claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of
15 Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

16 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.31 of Title 47, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section
20 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for Oklahoma Dental
21 Association Mission of Mercy license plates shall be deposited to
22 the Oklahoma Dental Association Mission of Mercy License Plate
23 Revolving Fund created in subsection B of this section.

24

1 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
2 fund for the State Department of Health to be designated the
3 "Oklahoma Dental Association Mission of Mercy License Plate
4 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject
5 to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received
6 by the State Department of Health pursuant to subsection A of this
7 section. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
8 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the State
9 Department of Health for the purpose of providing grants to the
10 Oklahoma Dental Association for the Mission of Mercy free dental
11 clinic. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
12 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
13 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
14 Services for approval and payment.

15 SECTION 9. AMENDATORY 52 O.S. 2011, Section 288.7, as
16 amended by Section 215, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (52 O.S. Supp.
17 2015, Section 288.7), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 288.7. A. There is hereby created in the State
19 Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Energy Resources Board to
20 be designated the "Energy Resources Revolving Fund". The fund shall
21 be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations and
22 shall consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Energy
23 Resources Board from assessments received and collected pursuant to
24 Section 288.8A of this title, donations, grants, contributions and

1 gifts from any public or private source and monies deposited
2 pursuant to the provisions of Section 1135.5 of Title 47 of the
3 Oklahoma Statutes. The Board may expend funds as provided for by
4 law. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued
5 by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law
6 with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
7 Services for approval and payment.

8 B. Of the monies collected and not refunded pursuant to
9 Sections 288.8A and 288.9A of this title, a minimum of fifty percent
10 (50%) of said monies collected, including a prorated share of
11 administrative costs incurred from the effective date of this act,
12 and not subsequently refunded, shall be expended on environmental
13 cleanup and remediation projects related to oil and gas pollution
14 authorized by the Board from a priority list of projects submitted
15 by the Corporation Commission or, only in the absence of Corporation
16 Commission jurisdiction, projects submitted by other appropriate
17 state agencies.

18 C. None of the monies collected and not refunded pursuant to
19 Sections 288.8A and 288.9A of this title shall be used for travel
20 expenses of any member of the Oklahoma Legislature.

21 SECTION 10. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
