The State Regents shall consider and if 22 appropriate, shall approve the recommendations of the institution or 23 constituent agency pursuant to Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma

Constitution.

B. Beginning with the 2023-2024 academic year, the tuition, fee, and fine rates to be charged to students enrolled at an institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education shall not exceed the tuition, fee, and fine rates approved by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education or the institution's governing board of regents for the 2022-2023 academic year. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023. SECTION 3.
