6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to medical marijuana; amending 63
8 O.S. 2021, Section 427.9, as amended by Section 11,
9 Chapter 251, O.S.L. 2022 (63 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section
10 427.9), which relates to medical marijuana patient
11 license; extending time of renewal for certain
12 license; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 427.9, as
15 amended by Section 11, Chapter 251, O.S.L. 2022 (63 O.S. Supp. 2023,
16 Section 427.9), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 427.9. A. The Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority may
18 contact the recommending physician of an applicant for a medical
19 marijuana patient license or current holder of a medical marijuana
20 patient license to verify the need of the applicant or licensee for
21 the license and the information submitted with the application.

22 B. An applicant for a medical marijuana patient license who can
23 demonstrate his or her status as a one-hundred-percent-disabled
24 veteran as determined by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs and
codified at 38 C.F.R., Section 3.340(a) (2013) shall pay a reduced

1 ~~biannual~~ application fee of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00). The methods of
2 payment, as determined by the Authority, shall be provided on the
3 website. However, the Authority shall ensure that all applicants
4 have an option to submit the license application and payment by
5 means other than solely by submission of the application and fee
6 online.

7 C. The patient license shall be valid for up to two (2) years
8 from the date of issuance, unless the recommendation of the
9 physician is terminated pursuant to the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana
10 and Patient Protection Act or revoked by the Authority. Patient
11 licenses issued pursuant to subsection B of this section shall be
12 valid for up to ten (10) years from the date of issuance.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
