15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. Each school district and public charter school in this state
17	shall make feminine hygiene products available, at no cost, in
18	school restrooms designated for use by females.
19	B. For the purposes of this section, "feminine hygiene
20	products" means tampons and sanitary napkins for use in connection
21	with the menstrual cycle.
22	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
23	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
24	of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
