L1	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
L2	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-140a of Title 47, unless there
L3	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
L 4	A. The Department of Public Safety shall establish and
15	administer a pilot program to increase the availability of Advanced
L6	Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (ARIDE) training. The purpose
L7	of this program is to increase the number of peace officers

20	B. The Department is authorized to provide funding, administer

23	SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
24	Public Safety for the purposes of the pilot program established in

Section 1 of this act from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department by law.
