10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
11	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-140a of Title 47, unless there
13	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
14	A. The Department of Public Safety shall establish and
15	administer a pilot program to increase the availability of Advanced
16	Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (ARIDE) training. The purpose
17	of this program is to increase the number of peace officers
18	qualified to conduct certain drug-impairment screening tests during
19	impaired driving investigations.
20	B. The Department is authorized to provide funding, administer
21	the program, and establish grant criteria regarding the
22	administration of the program.
23	SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
24	Public Safety for the purposes of the pilot program established in

1	Section 1 of this act from any monies not otherwise appropriated
2	from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal
3	year ending June 30, 2025, the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars
4	(\$500,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the
5	duties imposed upon the Department by law.
6	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
