20	shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment in the
21	custody of the county jail for a term not to exceed one (1) year, by
22	a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both
23	such imprisonment and fine.

       B. Any person who, without justifiable or excusable cause and
   with intent to do bodily harm, commits any battery or assault and
   battery upon the person of a municipal, county, or state official
   who is in the lawful performance of his or her duties of employment,

   imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a
   term not to exceed five (5) years, by a fine not to exceed Five
   Thousand Dollars ($5,000.00), or by both such imprisonment and fine.
       C. As used in this section, "official" includes any code
   enforcement, zoning, fire, health, or building official, or deputies

thereof, or any other person designated by law or ordinance to investigate, enforce, or perform duties within the scope of his or her employment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
