2. A course for which there is no tuition or fee charged to the student comparable to courses of similar time and commitment; or

- 3. A course, which is not directly relevant to a degree being pursued, that the student or the person or party financially responsible for the course objects to for philosophical or religious reasons.
- B. No student shall be penalized academically or financially for choosing not to enroll in a course pursuant to the provisions of subsection A of this section.
- C. If an institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education offers a voluntary course that meets the criteria of paragraphs 1, 2, or 3 of subsection A of this section, the course:
- 1. Shall include information regarding the powers and duties of the Oklahoma Free Speech Committee created pursuant to Section 3205.11 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes and statutory provisions regarding religious student associations provided for in Section 2119 et seq. of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and
 - 2. Shall include, at a minimum:
 - a. the text of the First Amendment of the United States
 Constitution,
 - b. resources discussing the principles and importance of free speech and viewpoint diversity, and
 - c. historical examples demonstrating the necessity of protecting unpopular speech in the United States and other nations.

D. An institution that offers a voluntary course in accordance with the provisions of subsection C of this section shall make available on its website, to the maximum extent allowed by law, a copy of or link to any audio or video materials, printed materials, or presentation slides distributed or presented to students as part of the course. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024. SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 59-2-2402 EΒ 12/13/2023 9:52:48 AM
