18	A. The Department of Wildlife Conservation shall administer
19	directly and through collaboration with the Oklahoma Department of
20	Agriculture, Food, and Forestry, the Oklahoma Conservation
21	Commission, and the Oklahoma Cooperative Extension Service at
22	Oklahoma State University to implement a program or programs for the
23	distribution of traps for the capture or deterrence of invasive and
24	nuisance species affecting Oklahoma landowners or land lessors.

B. The Department or any employee or agent of the Department
shall not be liable for damages in any civil suit or subject to
criminal prosecution for any injury resulting from the program,
unless the injury or death is a direct result of the gross
negligence, recklessness, or intentional misconduct of the
Department or employee or agent of the Department.

7 C. The Department of Wildlife Conservation shall promulgate the 8 rules necessary for the implementation of this program along with 9 any educational material necessary for the proper operation of the 10 traps leased to landowners and land lessors through this program as 11 not to violate the provisions of subsection B of this section. The 12 Department may allow exemptions for landowners and land lessors 13 participating in this program from the permits required to control 14 nuisance and invasive species set for in Title 29 of the Oklahoma 15 Statutes.
