## AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; prohibiting school districts that have adopted certain policy from converting to a charter school or receiving certain grants or scholarship accounts; providing for promulgation of rules; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-109.2 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
A. A school district that has adopted a school-hours policy pursuant to paragraph 2 of subsection A of Section 1-109 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes and offers classroom instruction not more than four (4) days per week shall not be eligible to:

1. Convert to a charter school pursuant to Section 3-132 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
2. Receive an educational improvement grant pursuant to the provisions of Section 2357.206 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes; or
3. Receive or benefit from empowerment scholarship accounts which may exist in the future.
B. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.
SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
