12	modifying requirements for the Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plate; updating statutory
13	reference; creating the Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary License Plate; creating the Bison
14	License Plate; creating the America First License Plate; creating the Oklahoma First License Plate;
15	creating the New State Brand License Plate; creating the Oklahoma American Legion Boys State License
16	Plate; creating the Edmond Public Schools Foundation License Plate; creating the Guthrie Street Kings
17	License Plate; providing for expenditures thereof; providing for design consultation; providing an
18	effective date; and declaring an emergency.

20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
21	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as
22	last amended by Section 1, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.
23	2019, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1135.2. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
 provided by this section.

5 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other 6 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of 7 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used 8 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been 9 registered for the current year.

10 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax 11 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall 12 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. 13 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor 14 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be 15 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and 16 17 amateur radio operator license plates.

18 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 19 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept 20 applications for special license plates authorized under this 21 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 22 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 23 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 24 information directly into such system and generate a receipt

accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

B. The special license plates provided by this section are as7 follows:

1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be 8 9 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United 10 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war 11 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification 12 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having 13 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving 14 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not 15 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 16 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war 17 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one 18 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 19 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 20 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 21 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title; 22

23 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National

Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

9 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed 10 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry 11 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or 12 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member 13 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably 14 15 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of present or past military 16 service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or 17 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or 18 former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof 19 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required 20 to provide proof of eligibility annually; 21

5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply

for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be 4 5 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse 6 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 7 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the 8 9 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon 10 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse 11 12 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in 13 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity 14 15 of one (1) ton or less;

7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be 16 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper 17 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs 18 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such 19 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration. 20 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate 21 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 22 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been 23 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not 24

since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee provided by this section for special license plates;

8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
the United States as being:

a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
7, 1941,

- b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
 exceed three (3) miles, and
- 16 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
 17 States Armed Forces.

Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
 States as being:

- a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
 of 1945,
- b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
- 5 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
 6 States Armed Forces.

Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for eachvehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

9 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and 10 11 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the 12 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB." at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such 13 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other 14 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the 15 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of 16 registration after the initial issue; 17

18 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be 19 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the 20 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of 21 the United States as being:

a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
1944,

1 a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of b. Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such 2 3 participation cannot be verified by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of 4 5 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its discretion, accept evidence of such participation from 6 7 the person applying for the license plate, and a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United 8 с. 9 States Armed Forces.

10 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less; 11 12 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were 13 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse 14 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 15 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action 16 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person 17 was killed in action and that the person making the application is 18 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse 19 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two 20 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) 21 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 22 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 23

all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

3 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were 4 5 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification 6 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making 7 the application is the parent of the deceased person. 8 The parent 9 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two 10 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one 11 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 12 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 13 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title; 14

15 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be 16 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the 17 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the 18 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or 19 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a 20 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated 21 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such

persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal 4 5 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and 6 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council 7 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may 8 9 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated 10 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of 11 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common 12 education police department by either an identification card or letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma 13 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for 14 15 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial 16 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in 17 consultation with municipal police departments of this state; 18 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design 19 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in 20 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate; 21 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 22 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United 23

States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be

verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may
apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

7 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia 8 9 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold 10 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps, Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which 11 12 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate 13 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. 14 15 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words "WORLD WAR II"; 16

17 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 18 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United 19 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be 20 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of 21 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having 22 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June 23 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former

24

members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for
 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

3 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia 4 5 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or 6 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member 7 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the 8 9 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two 10 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the 11 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

12 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be 13 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and 14 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or 15 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only 16 be produced upon application;

Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be 19. 17 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are 18 residents of this state. Such persons must present an 19 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a 20 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with 21 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend 22 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the 23 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and 24

three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

7 20. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed 8 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the 9 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and 10 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert 11 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity 12 of one (1) ton or less;

13 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be 14 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of 15 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may 16 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle 17 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

18 22. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
19 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
20 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
21 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

22 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
24 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate

1 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 2 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license 3 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

4 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed
5 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for
6 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety7 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
8 the Ninety-Nines;

9 25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge. 10 11 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend 12 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge". 13 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate 14 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 15 less; 16

17 26. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall 18 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member 19 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United 20 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat 21 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying 22 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

23 27. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of

Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

4 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
5 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
6 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
7 United States Secretary of Defense;

Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be 8 29. 9 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission 10 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any 11 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as 12 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying 13 capacity of one (1) ton or less; 14

15 30. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed 16 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate 17 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the 18 district number;

19 31. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be 20 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United 21 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the 22 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected 23 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which 24 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been

1 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a 2 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability 3 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons 4 5 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no 6 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying 7 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any 8 9 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or 10 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or 11 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and 12 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans 13 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 14 The fee provided by this section for the special license plate 15 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other 16 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees 17 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this 18 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00). 19

If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized

1 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled 2 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the 3 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to 4 the Tax Commission;

5 32. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such 6 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force 7 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show 8 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be 9 designed in consultation with the Association;

10 33. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such 11 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state 12 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for 13 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 14 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 15 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the 16 Academy; 17

34. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment. Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle

1 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such 2 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax 3 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call 4 5 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All 6 7 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for 8 9 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee 10 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other 11 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant 12 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio 13 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall 14 15 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. 16 The right to such special identification plates herein provided for 17 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the 18 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked; 19 35. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be 20

21 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for 22 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license 23 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of 24 Oklahoma;

1 36. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be 2 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or 3 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or 4 5 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the 6 7 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension. 8 9 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 10 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 11 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be 12 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this 13 state;

14 37. Gold Star Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates 15 shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of 16 qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran" 17 shall mean:

18a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the19United States Armed Forces or as a member of the20Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result21of the performance of duties for any branch of the22United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard23while on active military duty, or

24

b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of
injury, illness or disease caused by the performance
of such duties while on active duty, whether the death
occurred while on active duty or after the honorable
discharge of such person.

8 The fee provided by this section for the special license plate 9 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other 10 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees 11 levied by Section 1132 of this title;

12 38. Korea Defense Service Medal License Plates - such plates 13 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who has 14 been awarded the Korea Defense Service Medal by the United States 15 Secretary of Defense. Such persons may apply for a Korea Defense 16 Service Medal license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying 17 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

39. 180th Infantry License Plates - such plates shall be designed for members and prior members of the 180th Infantry. Persons applying for such license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership from the 180th Infantry Association. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 180th Infantry;

1 40.
