

1 shall consist of all monies received by the State Department of
2 Education from:

3 1. Reimbursements, grants, or other monies received from other
4 state agencies and entities for school security;

5 2. Reimbursements, grants, or other monies received from the
6 United States government obligated to school security projects;

7 3. Gifts, donations, and bequests; and

8 4. Monies appropriated or apportioned by the Legislature.

9 B. All monies accruing to the credit of the School Security
10 Revolving Fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and
11 expended by the State Department of Education for the purposes of:

12 1. Establishing and maintaining a School Resource Officer
13 Program; and

14 2. Providing physical security enhancements for schools
15 including, but not limited to, school resource officers, cameras,
16 gates, lighting, locks, doors, windows, security geofencing, and
17 ballistic storm shelters.

18 Monies in the School Security Revolving Fund shall supplement and
19 not supplant existing school security funding.

20 C. Expenditures from the School Security Revolving Fund shall
21 be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims
22 filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of
23 Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

24 ~~Expenditures~~ Annual school district allocations from the School

1 Security Revolving Fund shall not exceed Fifty Million Dollars
2 (\$50,000,000.00) in any fiscal year and shall be divided equally
3 among every public school district in the state.

4 D. Beginning July 1, 2024, statewide virtual charter schools
5 shall not be included in the annual allocations provided for in
6 subsection C of this section.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

8 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
