13	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
14	A. Subject to the limitations of subsection B of this section,
15	the State Department of Health shall publicize in a manner
16	determined by the State Commissioner of Health all immunization
17	records and other immunization data stored by the Department.
18	B. The Department shall only release de-identified immunization
19	records or data and shall otherwise comply with all state and
20	federal privacy laws including but not limited to the Health
21	Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996.
22	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
