10 An Act relating to prescription drugs; directing
11 certain entity to conduct certain analysis regarding
12 prescription opioids; directing submission of certain
13 report; providing for codification; and providing an
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.9c of Title 36, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The College of Pharmacy at Southwestern Oklahoma State
20 University shall analyze the effectiveness of the anti-abuse
21 properties of anti-abuse-formulated opioids. In addition, the
22 College of Pharmacy shall analyze the discrepancies between
23 insurance coverage for the anti-abuse-formulated prescription
24 opioids and coverage for prescription opioids without abuse-

1 deterrent properties. Such information shall be submitted in a
2 report to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of
3 the House of Representatives on or before December 31, 2016.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
