15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-103.2 of Title 70, unless
18	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. For each student who transfers from an elementary school
20	district, which is the resident district of the student, to an
21	independent district to attend a grade the student is entitled to
22	pursue pursuant to Section 8-101 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma
23	Statues, the elementary school district shall provide to the
24 23	independent school district a proportional amount of monies derived

1 from the proceeds of the school levies made pursuant to the 2 provisions of:

⁴ Constitution;

5 2. Subsection (b) of Section 9 of Article X of the Oklahoma 6 Constitution;

7 3. Subsection (c) of Section 9 of Article X of the Oklahoma 8 Constitution;

9 4. Subsection (d) of Section 9 of Article X of the Oklahoma 10 Constitution; and

5. Subsection (d-1) of Section 9 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution.

B. The State Department of Education shall provide assistance to elementary school districts in calculating the amounts described in subsection A of this section and a schedule of payments.

16 C. Payments made to an independent school district pursuant to 17 subsection A of this section shall be included in the calculation of 18 State Aid pursuant to Section 18-200.1 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma 19 Statutes.

D. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules
 necessary to implement the provisions of this act.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
