 - a. a vehicle passes an emissions inspection every two (2) years by not emitting more than a standard set by the Department of Public Safety,
 - b. a certificate or other documentation showing the vehicle identification number, date of last emissions inspection, and whether the vehicle is in compliance with the provisions of this section and of the rules and regulations promulgated as prescribed in this section is provided to the vehicle owner at the time an inspection is completed,
 - c. a vehicle owner maintains in the vehicle at all times an emissions inspection certificate demonstrating the vehicle is in compliance with the testing requirements promulgated according to the provisions of this section,
 - d. all vehicles that require annual vehicle registration renewal participate including, but not limited to, passenger vehicles and light trucks,
 - e. drivers present certification of the vehicle passing emissions inspection within the prior two (2) years as a prerequisite to renewing registration,
 - f. hybrid vehicles obtain an On-Board Diagnostic (OBD) emission inspection,
