15	the time the will is admitted to probate is:
16	1. Under the age of majority- <u>;</u>
17	2. Convicted of $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$ crime. $\frac{1}{2}$ that causes the court to
18	determine that the person should not be entrusted with the fiduciary
19	duties of an executor; or
20	3. Adjudged by the court incompetent to execute the duties of
21	the trust by reason of drunkenness, improvidence, or want of
22	understanding and integrity.
23	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 58 O.S. 2021, Section 126, is
24	amended to read as follows:

1	Section 126. No person is competent to serve as administrator
2	or administratrix, who, when appointed, is:
3	1. Under the age of majority $\div$ ;
4	2. Convicted of $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$ crime. $\frac{1}{2}$ that causes the court to
5	determine that the person should not be entrusted with the fiduciary
6	duties of an administrator; or
7	3. Adjudged by the court incompetent to execute the duties of
8	the trust by reason of drunkenness, improvidence or want of
9	understanding or integrity.
