An Act

ENROLLED SENATE BILL NO. 1604

An Act relating to the State Board of Career and Technology Education; directing certain expenditures; providing for increase in compensation for certain certified personnel; providing for increase in compensation for certain support employees; providing for the duties and compensation of employees; providing lapse dates; requiring certain budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: State Board of Career and Technology Education

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. Of the funds appropriated to the State Board of Career and Technology Education in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1600 of the 2nd Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, Ten Million One Hundred Eighteen Thousand Nine Hundred Seven Dollars (\$10,118,907.00) shall be for the purpose of providing an increase in compensation for certified personnel, as defined in Section 26-103 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated to the State Board of Career and Technology Education in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1600 of

the 2nd Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, Two Million Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$2,060,000.00) shall be for the purpose of providing an increase in compensation for support employees, as defined in Section 26-103 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education by law shall be set by the Board. The Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 4. Appropriations made to the State Board of Career and Technology Education in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1600 of the 2nd Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (hereafter FY-19), or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 (hereafter FY-20). Funds budgeted for FY-19 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2019 and must be expended by November 15, 2019. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2019, and not budgeted for FY-20 shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-20 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2020. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2020 shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-19, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budged for FY-20, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-19 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
