7 An Act relating to public finance; amending Section
8 10, Chapter 209, O.S.L. 2013 (62 O.S. Supp. 2015,
9 Section 901.1), which relates to the Long-Range
10 Capital Planning Commission; setting forth procedure
11 for substitution of emergency projects by state
12 agencies; specifying duties of Director of Office of
13 Management and Enterprise Services; requiring
14 approval of President Pro Tempore of Senate and
15 Speaker of House of Representatives; providing an
16 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 10, Chapter 209, O.S.L.
2013 (62 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 901.1), is amended to read as
follows:

Section 901.1. A. The Long-Range Capital Planning Commission
shall submit an itemized list of the proposed projects set forth in
its annual capital plan to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore
of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives within
the first seven (7) legislative days of a regular legislative
session. The list shall be in the order of the priority of the
projects as determined by the Commission. The submission to such

1 | elected officials shall occur upon the same date for purposes of
2 | computing the time within which action must be taken as further
3 | prescribed by this subsection. The Legislature shall have a period
4 | of forty-five (45) calendar days from the date on which the list is
5 | submitted to pass a concurrent resolution disapproving any or all of
6 | the proposed projects. If the Legislature does not disapprove any
7 | proposed project by concurrent resolution by the end of the forty-
8 | fifth day following the date upon which the proposed issuance is
9 | submitted, the proposed projects shall be deemed to have been
10 | approved by the Legislature.

11 | B. Upon approval of all or any part of the list of proposed
12 | projects, the Office of Management and Enterprise Services may
13 | expend funds in the Maintenance of State Buildings Revolving Fund
14 | for approved projects in the order of priority set forth in its
15 | annual capital plan.

16 | C. In the event an emergency has been declared as provided for
17 | in Section 130 of Title 61 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and as a result
18 | thereof, repair or maintenance of a capital facility held by the
19 | state is required, a state agency may submit a request to the
20 | Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to
21 | substitute the emergency project for any other project or projects
22 | of the state agency on the approved current fiscal year's Capital
23 | Improvement Plan list, or to add the emergency project if the state
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1 agency does not have any projects on the approved current fiscal
2 year's Capital Improvement Plan list; provided:

3 1. The Director determines that there are funds available in
4 the Maintenance of State Buildings Revolving Fund to cover all or
5 part of the cost of the emergency project; and

6 2. The Director submits information on the emergency project
7 and the cost thereof to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and
8 the Speaker of the House of Representatives and they approve the
9 substitution within five (5) calendar days of such submission.

10 D. The Director has authority to redirect funds within the
11 Maintenance of State Buildings Revolving Fund for emergency projects
12 approved by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker
13 of the House of Representatives.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.

15 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
