12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1435, as
13	amended by Section 1, Chapter 245, O.S.L. 2022 (21 O.S. Supp. 2023,
14	Section 1435), is amended to read as follows:
15	Section 1435. A. Every person who breaks and enters the
16	dwelling house of another, in which there is at the time no human
17	being present, or any commercial building or any part of any
18	building, room, booth, tent, railroad car, or other structure or
19	erection in which any property is kept or who enters into a
20	restricted area of a commercial building without authorization or
21	breaks into or forcibly opens, any coin-operated or vending machine
22	or device with intent to steal any property therein or to commit any
23	felony, is guilty of burglary in the second degree.

1	B. Every person who breaks and enters, climbs under, or uses
2	any jack stands or any other item to raise any automobile, truck,
3	trailer or vessel of another, in which any property is kept, with
4	intent to:
5	1. Steal any property therein;
6	2. Steal any property attached thereto; or
7	3. Commit any felony,
8	is guilty of burglary in the third degree.
9	C. As used in subsection B of this section, the term "property
10	attached thereto" includes, but is not limited to, tires, wheels,
11	and catalytic converters.
