## 1 SENATE FLOOR VERSION February 20, 2024 2 SENATE BILL NO. 1743 3 By: Pederson of the Senate and 4 5 Hays of the House 6 7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; requiring payment 8 of certain claims for towing services directly to 9 wrecker operator; allowing licensed wrecker operator to take possession of impounded vehicle tag; requiring issuance of statement of charges owed; 10 requiring notification to Service Oklahoma following certain possession; directing Service Oklahoma to 11 issue certain designation upon notification; requiring remittance of license plate and 12 notification of received payment; defining term; prohibiting certain persons from issuing or renewing 13 vehicle tags for certain vehicle owners until certain received payment and tag remittance; directing rule 14 promulgation; providing for codification; and providing an effective date. 15 16 17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: 18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 953.3 of Title 47, unless there 20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 21 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an insurer accepting 22 liability for the payment of a claim for services performed by a 23 wrecker operator shall make that claim directly payable to the

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operator. Such services shall include, but are not limited to,
towing, nonconsensual towing, vehicle removal, and clearing of the
roadway of any glass or injurious substance following a vehicle
collision. The wrecker or towing operator shall provide written
documentation of the claim to the insurer prior to payment being
made.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 964.1 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. In the event that a licensed wrecker operator lawfully tows and stores a vehicle with a license plate, the wrecker operator shall issue a written statement of the amount owed by the insurer accepting liability for the claim for services performed by a wrecker operator, or to the vehicle owner responsible for payment if there is no insurer accepting liability. Following issuance of a statement under this section to a vehicle owner who is responsible for payment, or to an insurer accepting liability for the claim that does not pay the claim within the timeframe established under Section 1250.7 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the wrecker operator may remove and withhold the license plate affixed to the vehicle until payment is made to the wrecker operator by the insurer accepting liability for the claim or the vehicle owner responsible for payment.

B. 1. In the event that a wrecker operator removes and withholds a license plate under subsection A of this section the wrecker operator shall, within three (3) days, notify Service Oklahoma that the wrecker operator is withholding the license plate as a result of nonpayment.

- 2. Upon notification from a wrecker operator under this section, Service Oklahoma shall produce a stop flag designation to enable the wrecker operator to be paid prior to issuance of any license plate to the vehicle owner.
- 3. Upon payment in full of any charges contained on the statement, and any accrued storage charges, the wrecker operator shall remit the license plate to the vehicle owner and Service Oklahoma shall be notified that the vehicle owner is in compliance and possession of the license plate at issue.
- 4. For the purpose of this section, "stop flag designation" means a designation issued by Service Oklahoma to prevent the processing of vehicle related transactions, except those for taxes and fees due, title error, law enforcement request, or court order.
- C. Employees of Service Oklahoma and licensed operators in this state shall not issue a new or renewed tag to the vehicle owner whose license plate is in the possession of a wrecker operator for any vehicle owned by the person until all service charges have been paid and the license plate has been remitted by the wrecker operator.
