NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-104.10 of Title 70, unless 19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 20 A. Subject to the availability of funds, Nineteen Million 21 Dollars (\$19,000,000.00) shall be allocated by the State Board of 22 Education to award competitive grants to public school districts to:

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1. Pay in part or in whole the salary or wages of a school

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counselor;

- 2. Pay in part or in whole the salary or wages of a licensed professional counselor if the school district already employs at least one school counselor; or
- 3. Pay in part or in whole the salary or wages of a licensed clinical social worker if the school district already employs at least one school counselor.
- B. The State Board of Education shall establish a process for the consideration of grant proposals and shall determine criteria for grant proposals.
- C. A school district that is awarded a competitive grant pursuant to this section shall require the activities of the school counselor, licensed professional counselor or licensed clinical social worker whose salary or wages are paid in part or in whole by the grant to consist of eighty percent (80%) direct services with students and twenty percent (20%) indirect services with others on behalf of students.
- D. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
