4 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1914 of Title 69, unless there
6 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The Department of Transportation shall promulgate rules and
8 procedures to provide for all engineered plans for construction to
9 be available in an electronic three-dimensional format.

10 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1915 of Title 69, unless there
12 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The Department of Transportation shall promulgate rules and
14 procedures to provide a digital inspection process that allows for
15 real-time, transparent and accountable review of the process for
16 Department construction projects. The digital inspection process
17 shall:

- 18 1. Provide a real-time project feed with searchable, annotated
19 photos and videos;
- 20 2. Provide sharing of field-collected project information with
21 multiple stakeholder groups, including directly with industry
22 partners;

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- 1 3. Take a modular implementation approach to minimize risk for
2 the agency. However, it shall not be implemented as a single,
3 unified database;
- 4 4. Be designed to directly and securely exchange data with
5 external systems;
- 6 5. Provide flexibility to administer traditional design-bid-
7 build project types as well as alternative delivery project types
8 including, but not limited to, design-build or Construction
9 Manager/general contractor (CM/GC); and
- 10 6. Provide data-first, not form-first, data collection and
11 collaboration capabilities.

12 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
