NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 426.2 of Title 63, unless there 14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 15 Municipalities, political subdivisions, and counties may enter 16 into agreements or memoranda of understanding with state agencies 17 which respond to search and seizure activities of marijuana to 18 compensate municipalities, political subdivisions, or counties for 19 the use of county or municipal equipment during search and seizure 20 Agreements or memoranda made pursuant to the provisions of 21 this section shall not be reimbursed at a higher rate than the 22 federal schedule rate for equipment usage. 23
